## Meeting and Coordination



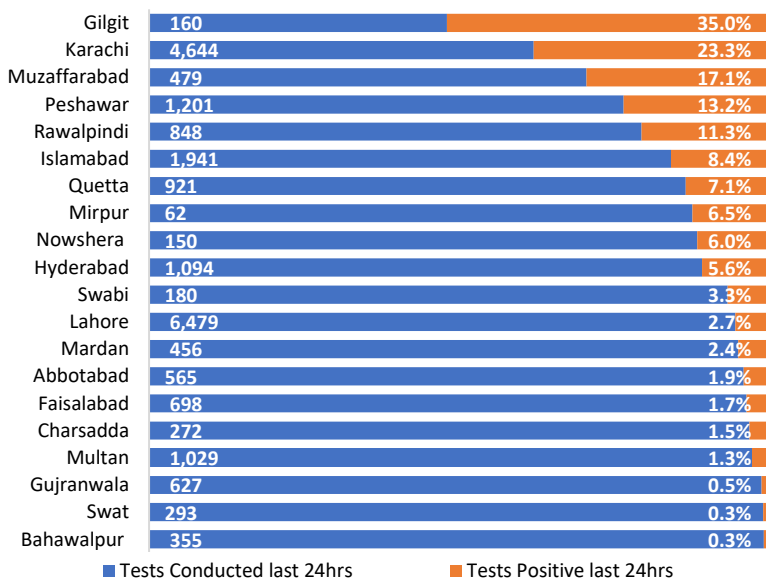
On 12<sup>th</sup> July 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala presided over certificate award ceremony to 15 graduands of a 2 months course on World Vector Surveillance and control. The participants are from vector borne disease programs and WCO Pakistan. The ceremony took place at the WHO Country Office, Islamabad.

This course was organized by WHO Regional Office for Eastern Mediterranean (EMR) with support from the National Environment Agency (NEA), Singapore and Centers for Disease Control (CDC), USA.

In his speech, the WR congratulated the participants for completion of the course and urged them to trickle-down the training to the rest of the vector borne disease staff in order to enhance vector borne disease prevention and control capacities in the country.
