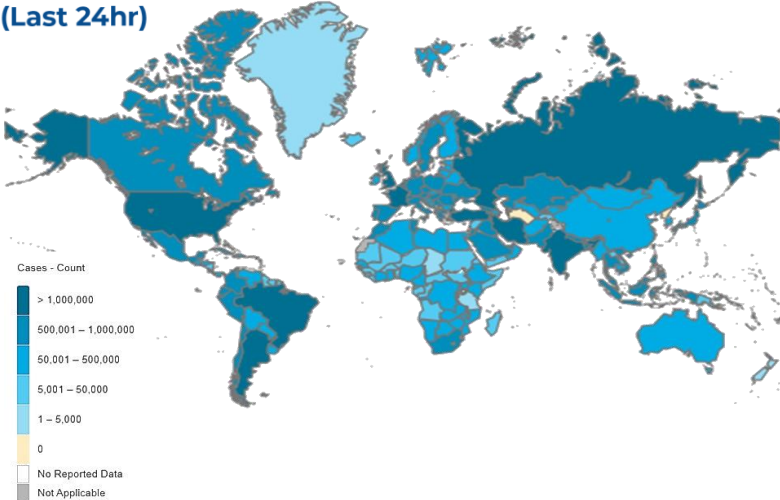
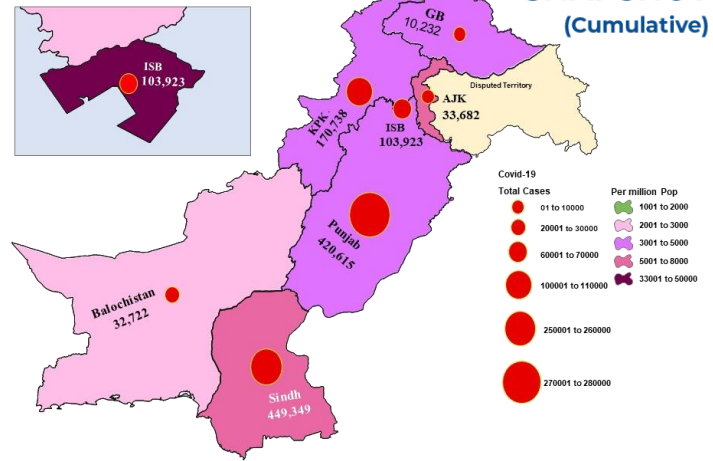

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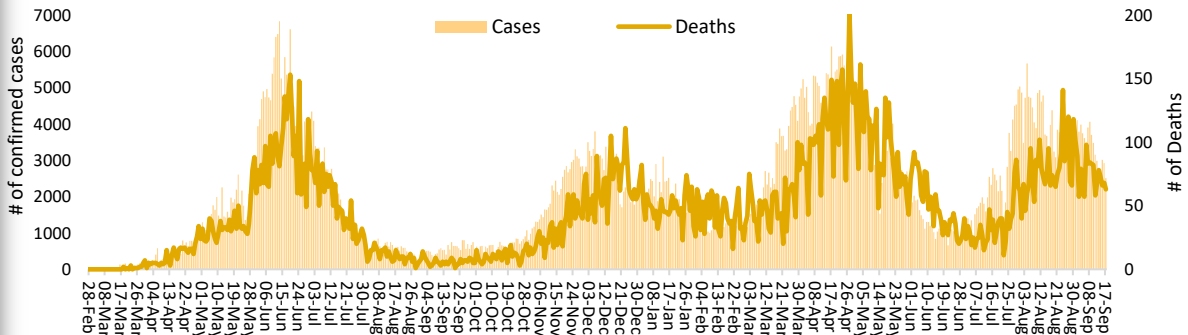

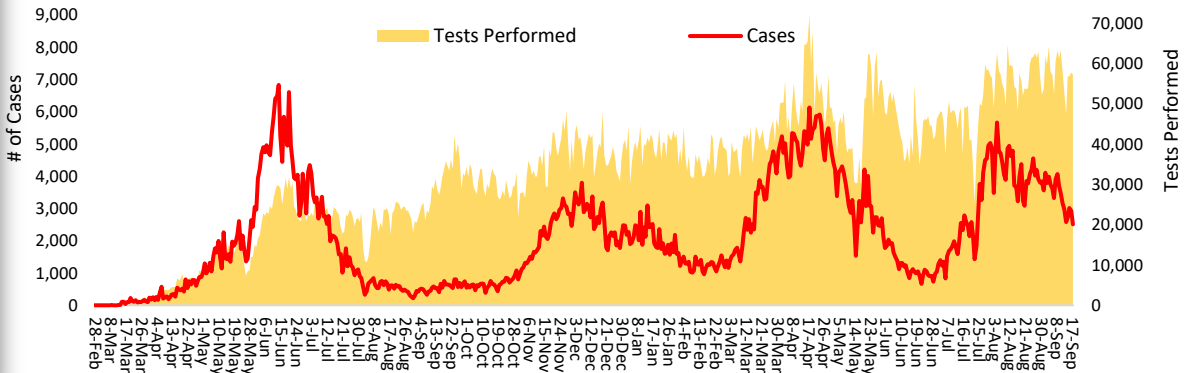

On 17th September 2021, Ministry of National Health Services Regulations & Coordination (MONHSR&C) in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan commemorated the World Patient Safety Day.
