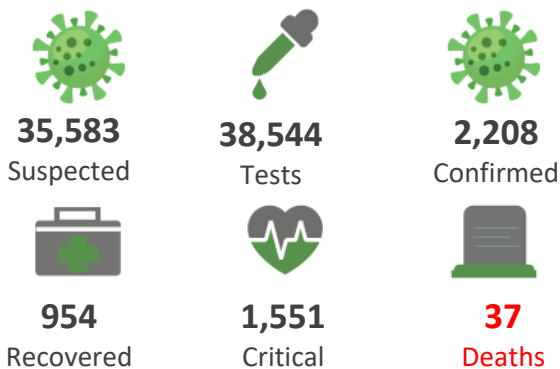


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



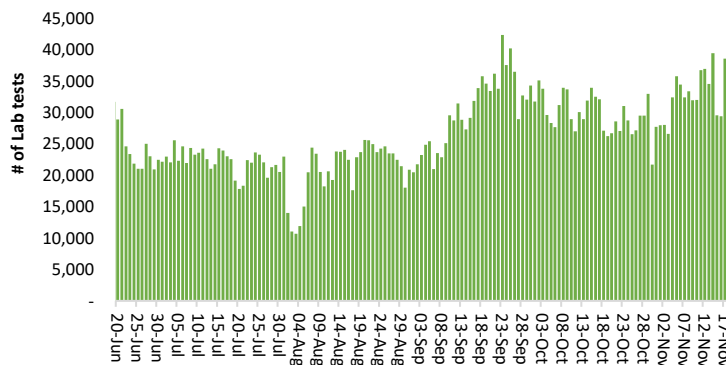
Pakistan reported **2,208** new cases of COVID-19 on **17 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **363,380** with **7,230** deaths (**CFR: 1.99%**). Out of the total **30,362** currently active cases, **1,769** cases are hospitalized.

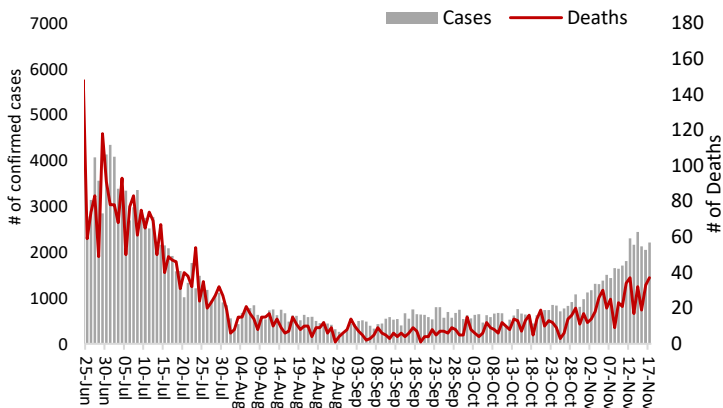

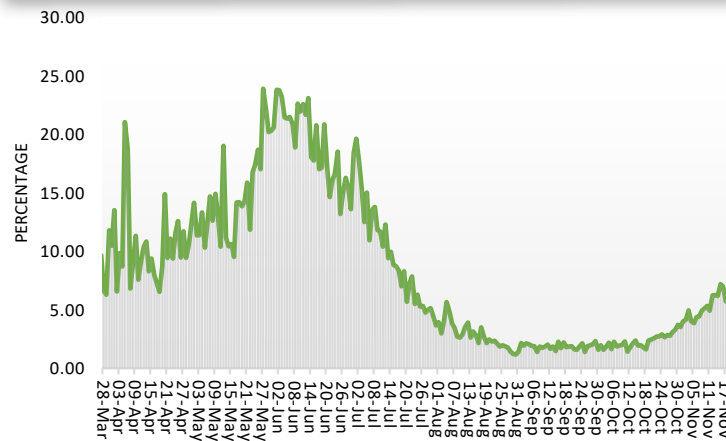


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

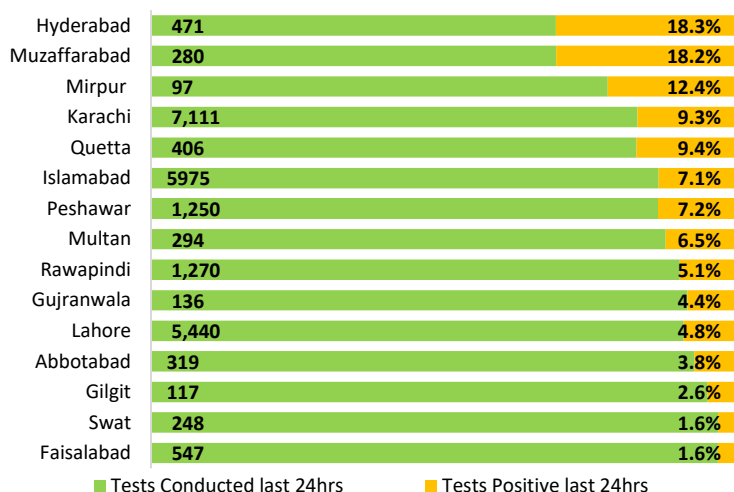
MEETINGS & COORDINATION

A webinar on country implementation of the Global Action Plan on Healthy Lives and Wellbeing (GAP) was held on 17 November. The webinar was chaired by Dr Syed Jaffar Hussein – Chef de Cabinet / EMRO, to discuss progress of implementation of GAP in the 8 priority countries.
