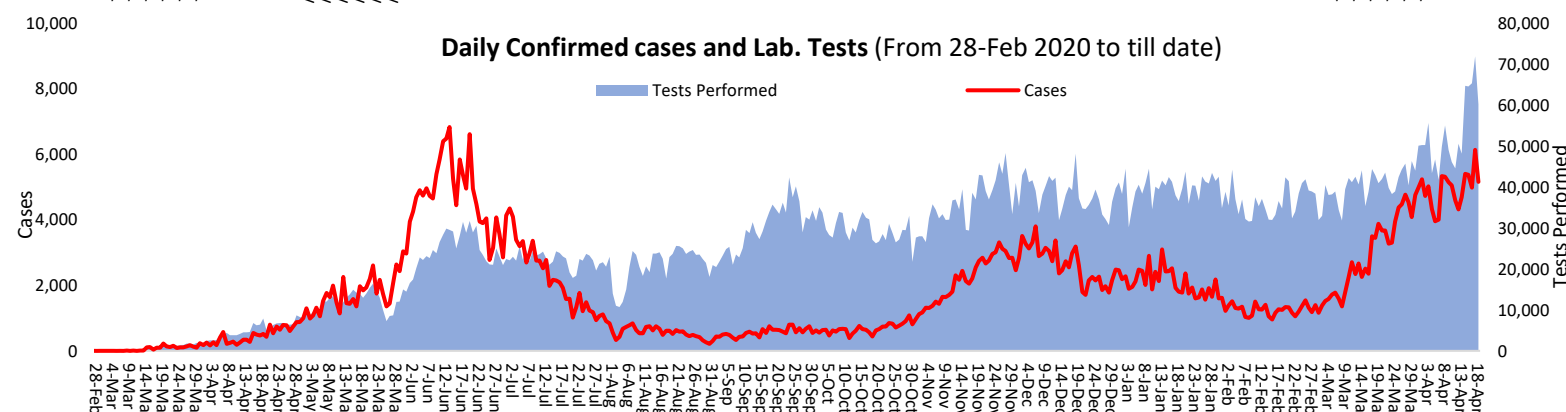

Meeting and Coordination

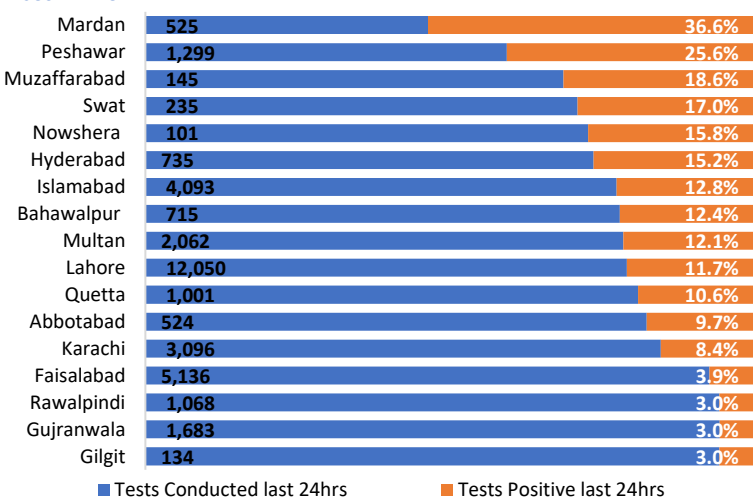


On 19th April 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala handed over one cardiac monitoring machine, 5000 KF94 Masks, 120 Hand Sanitizer bottles (500ml), Oxygen Concentrator and Pulse Oximeters to the Medical Director, Federal Government Hospital, Dr Mir Muhammad Hassan Bullo. District Health Officer Islamabad Dr Zaeem Zia, Incident Manger Dr Michael Lukwiya, WHO EPI Team lead, Dr Osama Mere and National Professional Officer, IHR Dr Farah Sabih attended the ceremony. The ceremony took place at Federal Government General Hospital Chak Shahzad, Islamabad.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha appreciated the well-coordinated and successful COVID-19 vaccine roll out in Pakistan. He highlighted that UN community is indebted to the Government of Pakistan for inclusion in the National Vaccine Deployment Plan.
