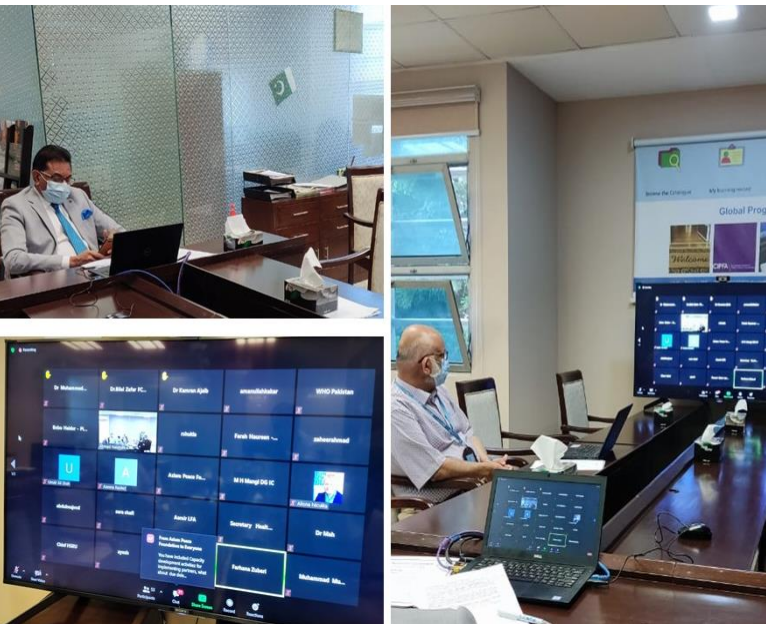


## FUNDS

## Meeting and Coordination

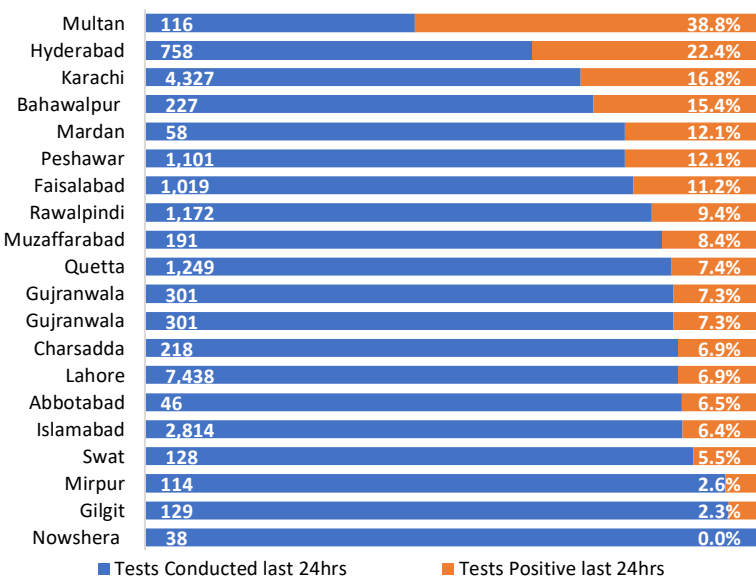


On the 19<sup>th</sup> May 2021, Ministry of Health conducted a virtual meeting of the Country Coordinating Mechanism (CCM) of the Global Fund (GF), chaired by the Secretary, Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination. The Meeting was convened to draw and endorse grants for HIV/AIDS, TB and Malaria and C19RM Fast Track funding request.

WHO Country Representative in Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala participated as the Chair of the Oversight Committee of the CCM and appreciated the leadership of the Federal and Provincial Ministries of Health and Partners for finalizing Global Fund Country Grant and the C19RM Fast Track proposal in particular to mitigate the effects of COVID-19 on TB, Malaria and HIV/AIDS. The WHO Country Office Pakistan extended the technical support to finalize these proposals. The WR Pakistan assured continued technical support from WHO Pakistan in this endeavor.
