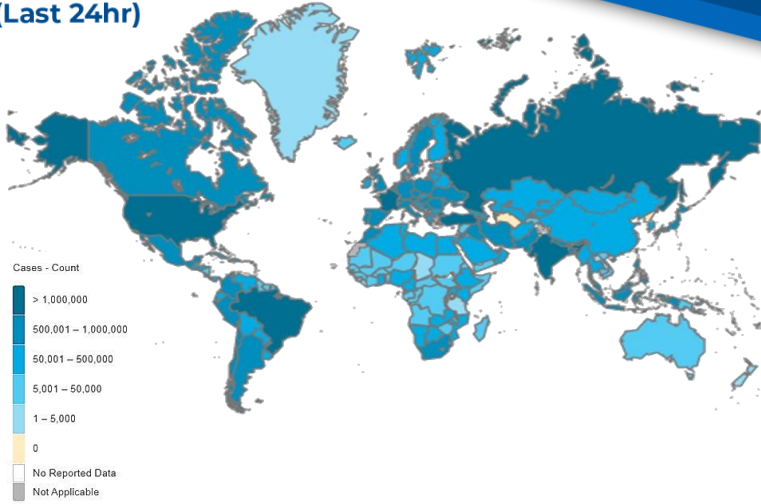


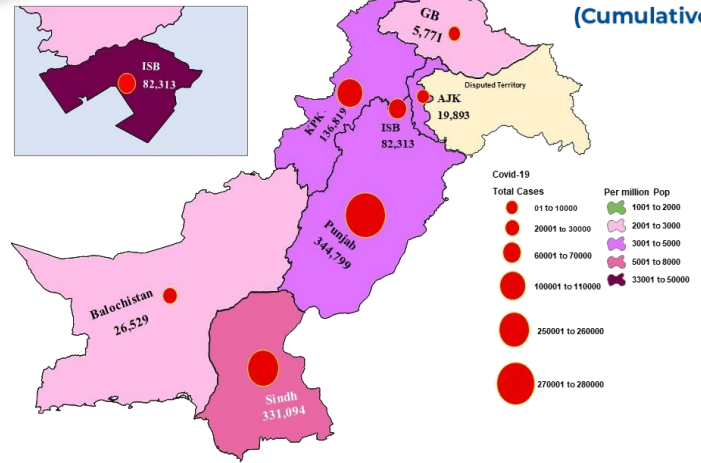

## PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

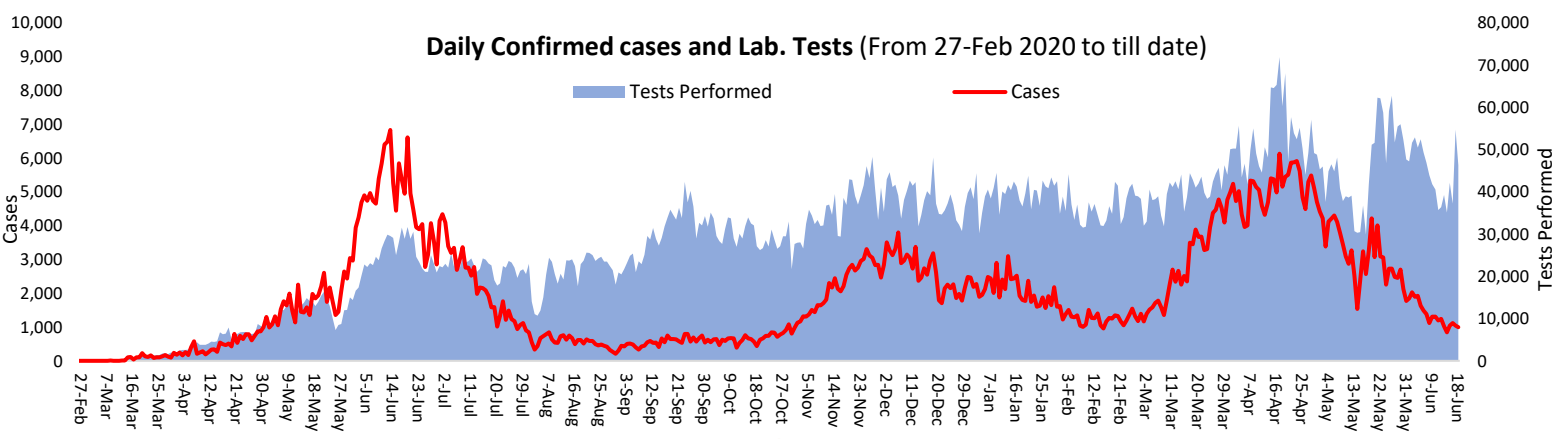
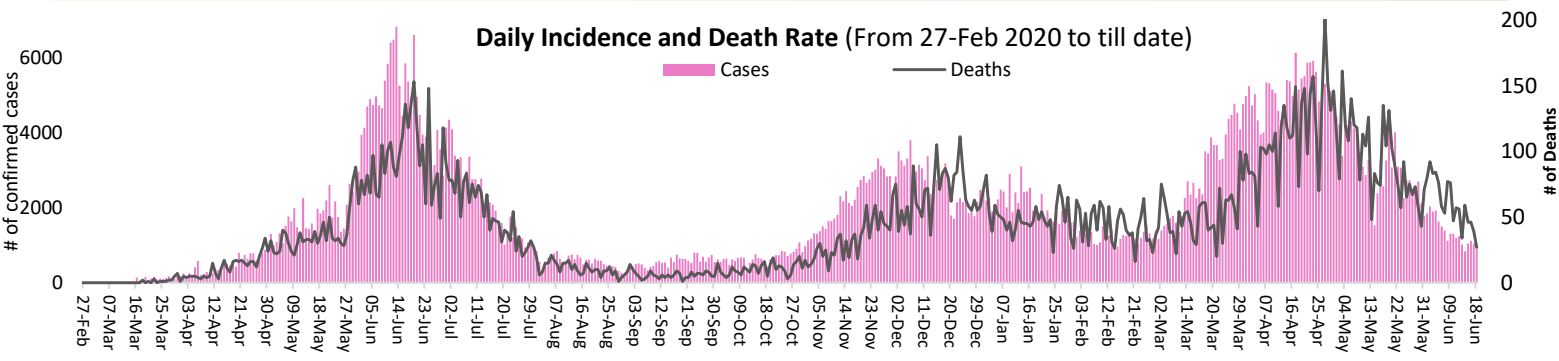

## Meeting and Coordination



On 18th June 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala paid courtesy visit to the Chief Minister Gilgit Baltistan, Mr. Khalid Khurshid Khan during his support supervisory visit to the province. The WR briefed the minister on the current effort by WHO to support the government of Pakistan to contain COVID-19 in the country and thanked the leadership of Gilgit Baltistan for their determined effort to contain COVID-19.

Dr Palitha handed over donation worth PKR 30.94 million, that included 2 Ambulances, 1 Double cabin, 15 Motorcycles and assortment of Medical and Laboratory supplies to the Chief Minister, he further announced plans to open 2 outdoor gymnasiums in Gilgit and Skardu region to promote health through physical activities.

The Chief Minister commended WHO for donations and presented a shield to Dr Palitha Mahipala in appreciation for the technical assistance by WHO in the COVID-19 response.
