

Executive Summary

Pakistan reported 645 new cases of COVID-19 on 18 **September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 305,031 with 6,415 deaths (CFR: 2.10%). Out of the total 6,572 currently active cases, 834 cases are hospitalized, out of which 562 (67.38%) are in critical condition. 5,738 COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of 292,044 (95.74%) have recovered and discharged.





Daily Incidence by Province






Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate



Trends of COVID-19 confirmed cases









by Major Cities / Districts




Occupied COVID-19 ventilators
