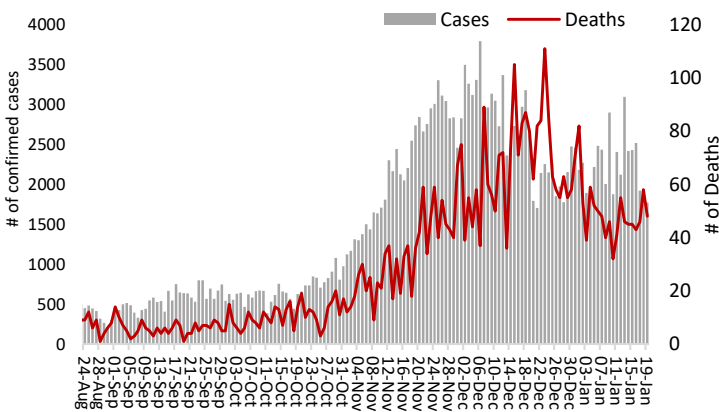

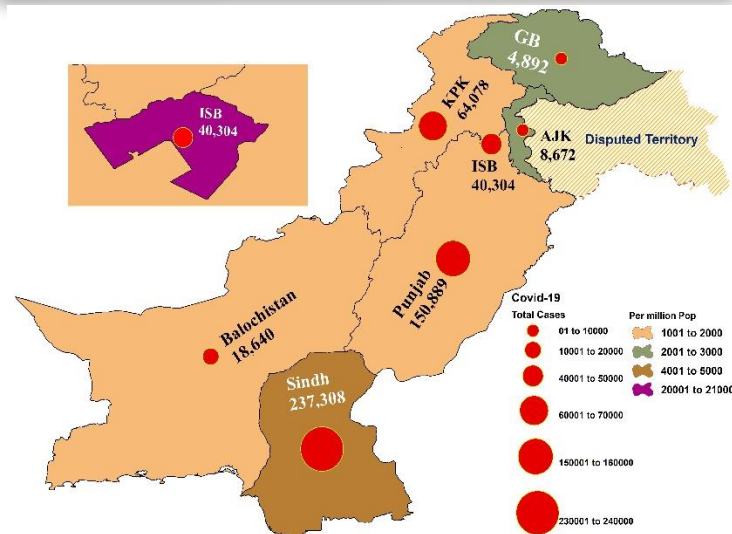


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

24-Aug 2020 - 19-Jan 2021



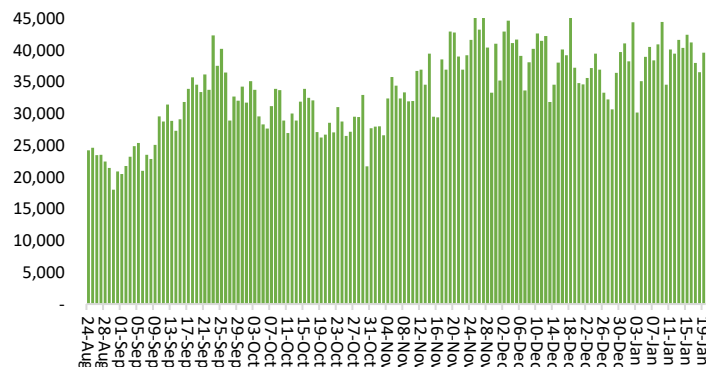
TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



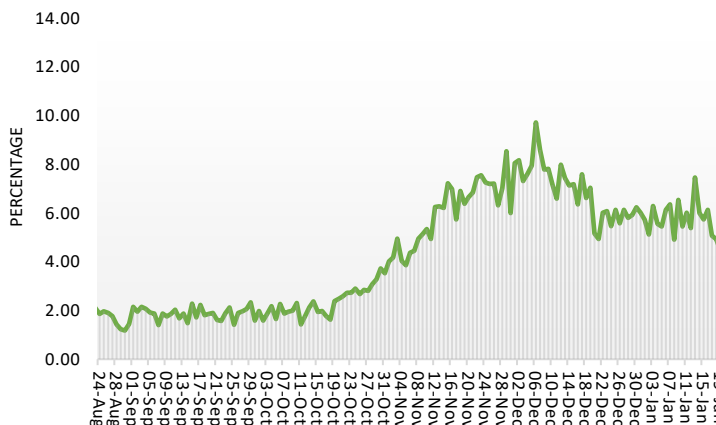
Pakistan reported **1,772** new cases of COVID-19 on **19 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **524,783** with **11,103** deaths (**CFR: 2.12%**). Out of the total **35,163** currently active cases **2,872** cases are hospitalized.
