







TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **1,340** new cases of COVID-19 on **19th February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **569,846** with **12,563** deaths (**CFR: 2.20%**). Out of the total **24,081** currently active cases **2,050** cases are hospitalized.


LAB TEST (PCR + RA) CONDUCTED BY DATE




INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 18th February 2021, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala visited the Planning and Monitoring Unit of Punjab Thalassemia Prevention Project (PTPP) at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital Lahore and met with the Program Manager, Dr Hussain Jaffari. During the meeting, the Program Manager informed the WR that PTPP project was conceived as part of the overall preventive strategy for Thalassemia in the health sector by the Government. Beta-thalassaemia (prevalence rate of 5.4%) is one of the most common genetically transmitted haematological disorders in the country. The WR was further informed that PTPP has established the first DNA lab in public sector and is providing free Thalassemia prevention services. In his remark, the WR appreciated the steps taken by the Government of Punjab in establishing the PTPP. In addition, he emphasized on the importance of promoting population screening as a more cost effective intervention keeping in view the long term treatment needs of thalassaemic patients.
