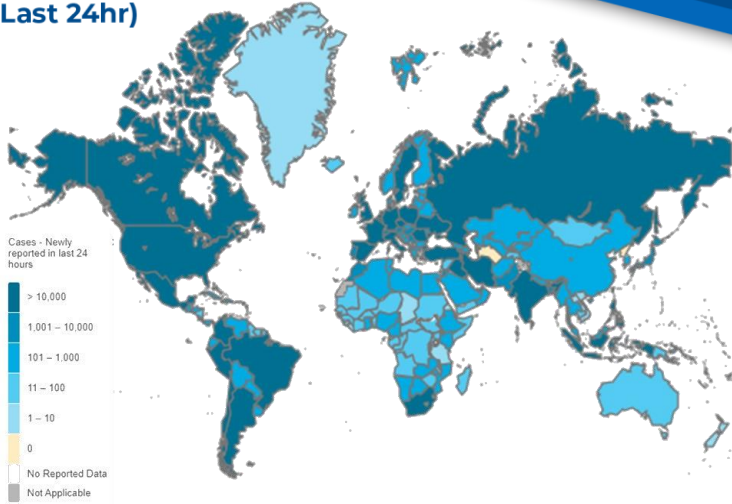


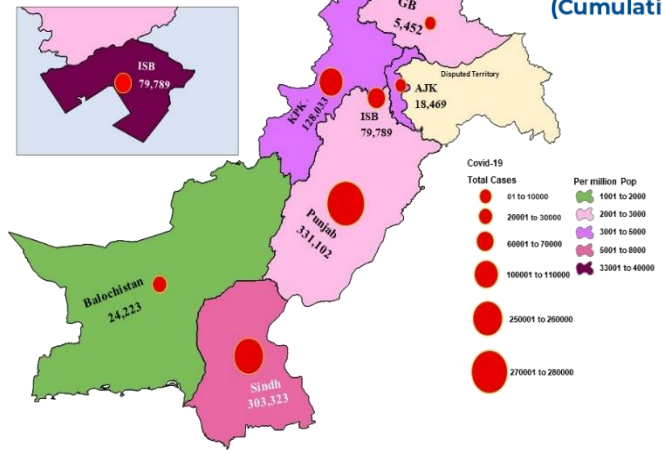

## PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

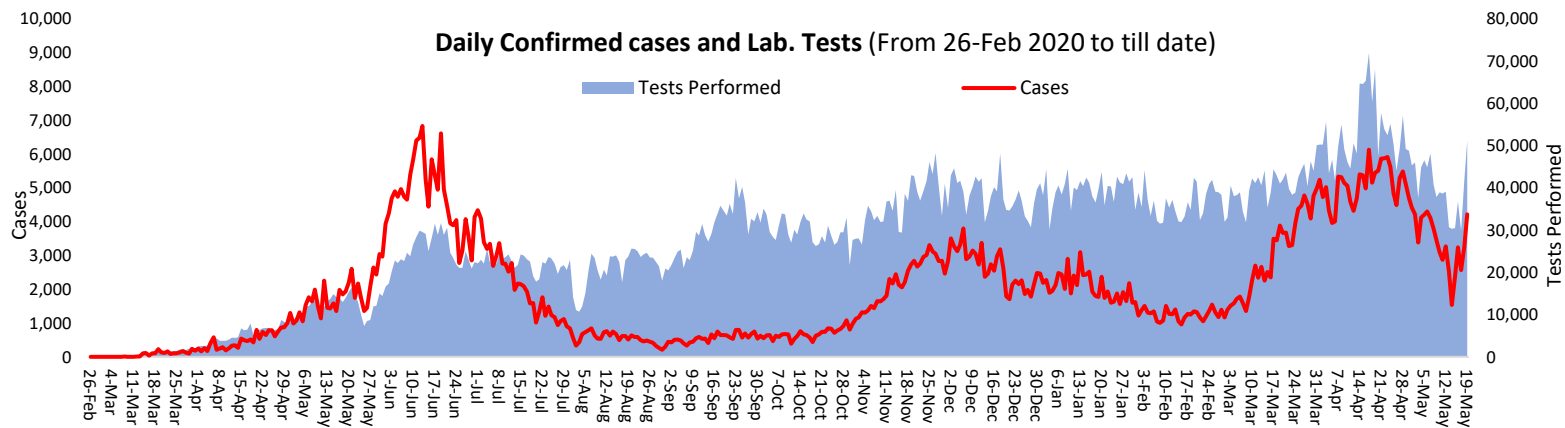
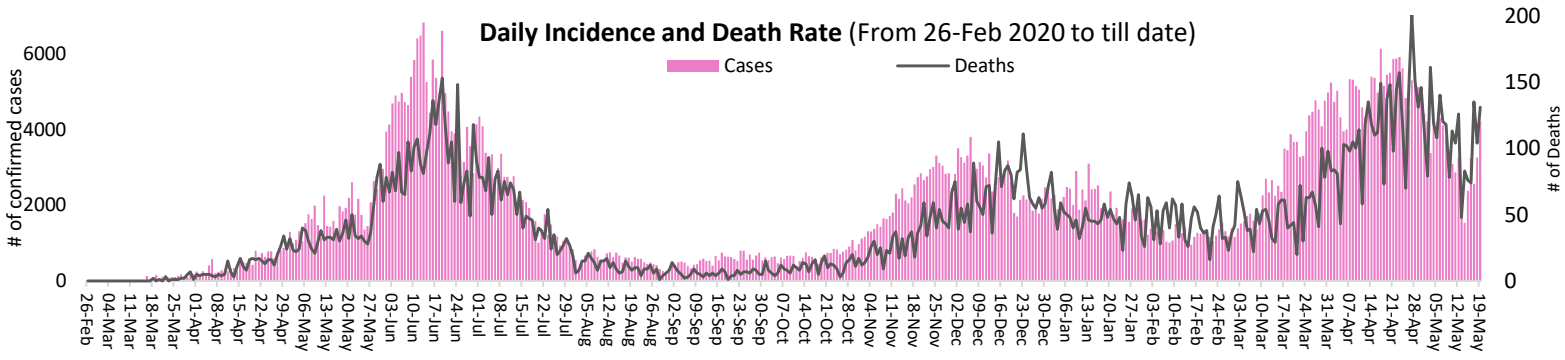

## Meeting and Coordination



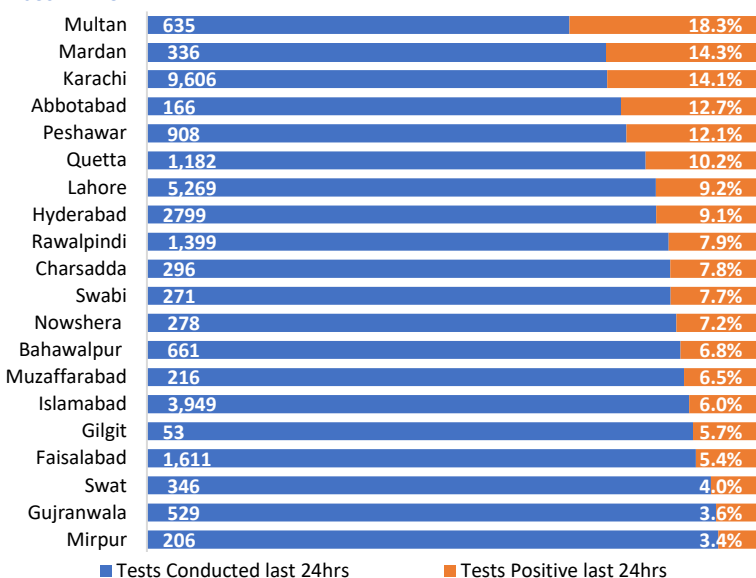
On the 19<sup>th</sup> May 2021, UN Resident coordinators' Office, Pakistan and WHO Country Office, Pakistan organized a virtual townhall meeting for all UN staff and service contract holders to update them on the current COVID 19 situation and the response measures recommended. The meeting was chaired by United Nations Resident Coordinator, Mr. Julien Harneis.

During the meeting, the WR, Dr Palitha Mahipala briefed the UN community on the global, regional, and Pakistan COVID-19 situation and outlined the Government's strategy in the COVID-19 response. particularly, efforts in vaccination rollout, laboratory testing, case management and risk communication and community engagement.

The RC thanked WHO Pakistan for their technical and financial support to the COVID-19 response in Pakistan.
