
PAKISTAN CIVID-19 SITUATION REPORT





Meeting and Coordination







On 18th June 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala and Additional Secretary Health Gilgit Baltistan Mr Azam Khan inaugurated the nutrition stabilization center in the Provincial Headquarter Hospital, Gilgit-Baltistan. The inauguration ceremony was attended by District Health Officer, Gilgit, Dr Mubeen and Medical Superintendent PHQ Hospital Gilgit, Dr Farman Allah. During his speech, the Additional Secretary Health applauded the efforts of WHO Pakistan and requested support for upscaling similar centres and establishing more stabilization centers in high burden areas of Gilgit Baltistan.

The WR appreciated the service quality for treating severely acute malnourished children with complications at the stabilization center and emphasized on the need for maintenance of the service quality. He further pledged to continue supporting the management of severely acute malnourished children and counseling of pregnant lactating mothers on balanced diet and infant young child feeding practices.
