






On 16<sup>th</sup> September 2021, Ministry of National Health Services Regulations and Coordination in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan conducted a technical working group meeting to finalize the Plan of Action for NCD and Mental health. The meeting was held at Ramada Hotel, Islamabad and the inauguration ceremony was graced by WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala, Vice Chancellor, Health Services Academy Dr Shahzad Ali Khan, and Deputy Director Programs MoNHSRC Dr Samara Mazhar.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha highlighted on the burden of non-communicable disease in Pakistan and called for a multi-sectoral collaboration and advocated for the implementation of “WHO Best Buys” for the prevention and control of NCDs in Pakistan. Dr Samra appreciated the technical support of WHO in the development of the National Action Plan on NCDs.
