



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



Pakistan reported **2,363** new cases of COVID-19 on **20 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **527,146** with **11,157** deaths **(CFR: 2.12%)**. Out of the total **35,293** currently active cases **2,820** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

WHO Pakistan in collaboration with the National Institute of Health (NIH), Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination (NHSR&C) conducted a two days orientation training on Laboratory Accreditation system based on the ISO 15189:2012 standards for medical laboratories. The training was conducted at the Public Health Laboratories Division NIH from 20-21 January 2021. Sixteen participants from National and Provincial Laboratories participated which includes both didactic and group activities.

The orientation training is the first of a series of activities, to introduce the public health laboratory quality teams to the ISO 9001:2015 and Health laboratory accreditation standards 15189:2012, using a stepwise lab quality implementation approach.
