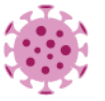

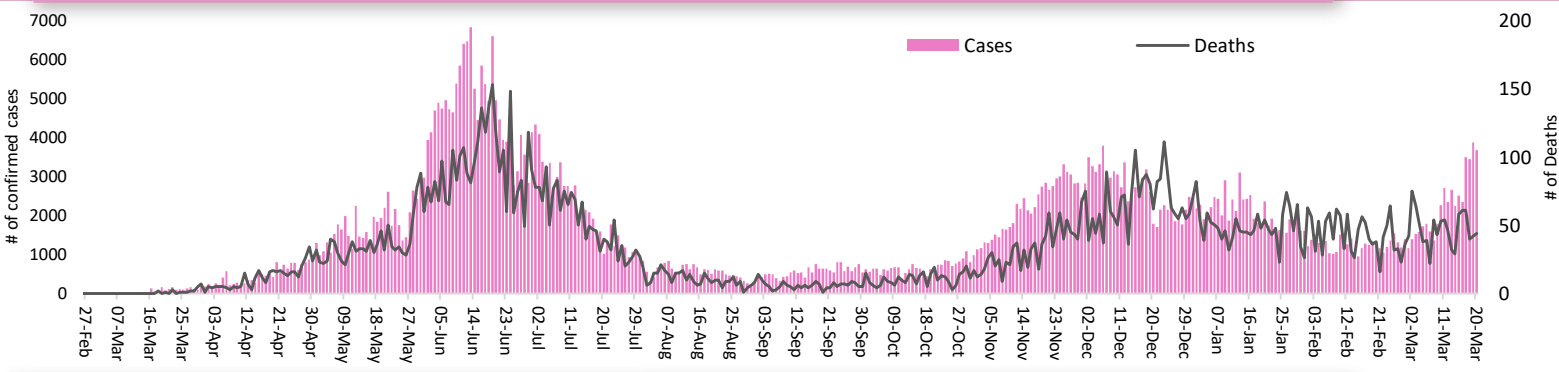

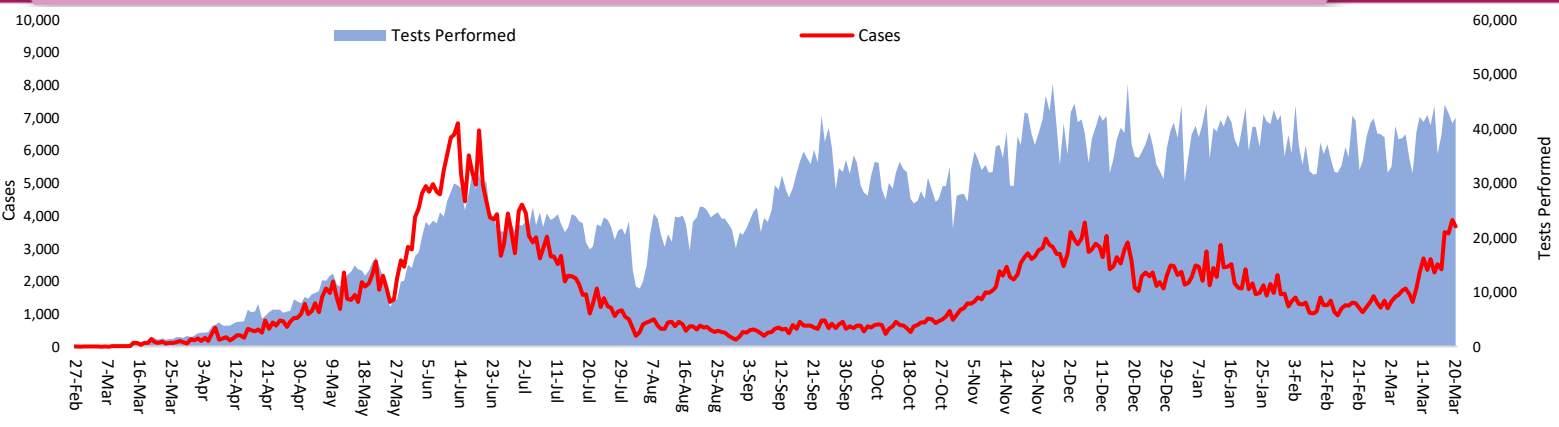

MEETING AND COORDINATION

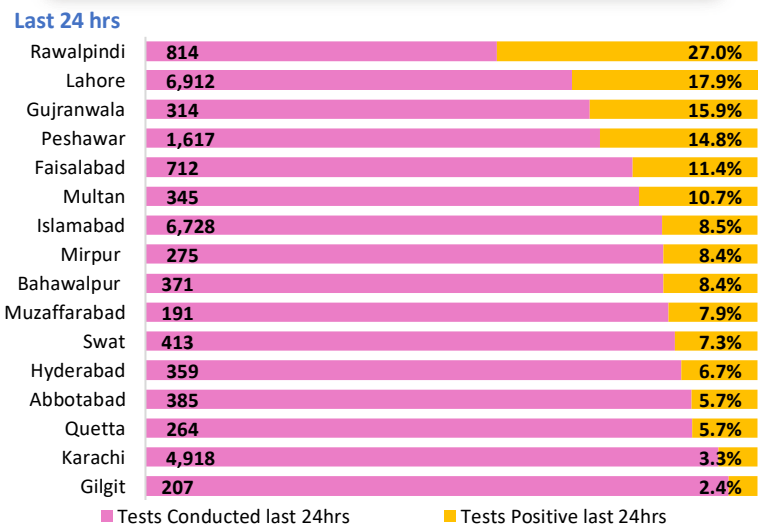


On 19th March 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with honorable Secretary for Health Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK), Major General Ahsan Altaf Satti (SH) and Director General Health, Dr Aftab Hussain Khan at the office of Secretary Health, Muzaffarabad.
