



Meeting and Coordination



On 19th June 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala accompanied by the Director General health Gilgit Baltistan, Dr Shakil Ahmed visited Ghulmit Hospital in Hunza district. The delegation was received by the Hospital in-charge, Dr Farhan Karim who gave a brief on the hospital functionality and, challenges to services delivery that included Ambulance services, and IT equipment for records management. After the hospital visit, the WR travelled to Sost at Pak-China border point and visited Civil Dispensary Sost and interacted with the community. While at the health facility the WR appreciated the health workers for the services they render. The WR on return paid a courtesy call to the Senior Minister Gilgit Baltistan, Lt. Col (R) Abaidullah Baig. The two discussed the health situation in GB. The chief minister applauded WHO for the support in strengthening health services in the province and requested for WHO support in establishing a rehabilitation centre for the differently abled people in Gilgit Baltistan.
