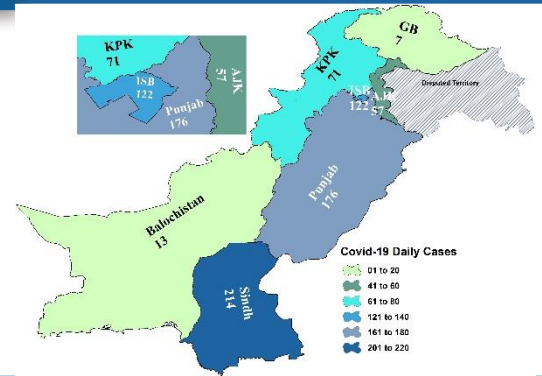

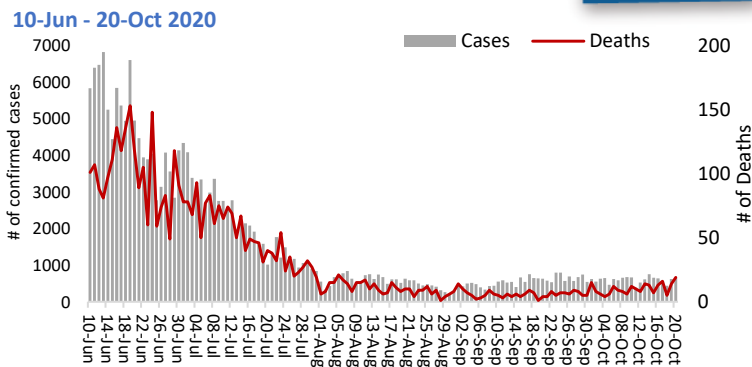
Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **660** new cases of COVID-19 on **20 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **324,744** with **6,692** deaths (**CFR: 2.06%**). Out of the total **9,378** currently active cases, **833** cases are hospitalized, out of which **559 (67.10%)** are in critical condition. **8,545** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **308,674 (95.05%)** have recovered and discharged.

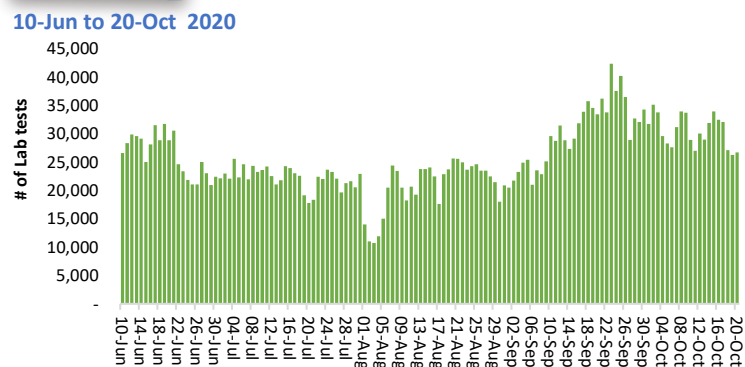
Daily Incidence by Province



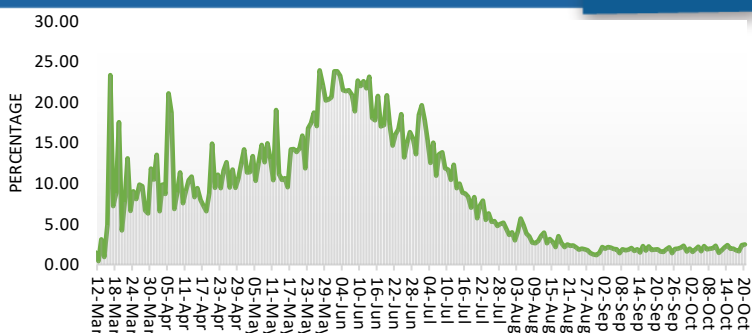
Daily Incidence/Mortality



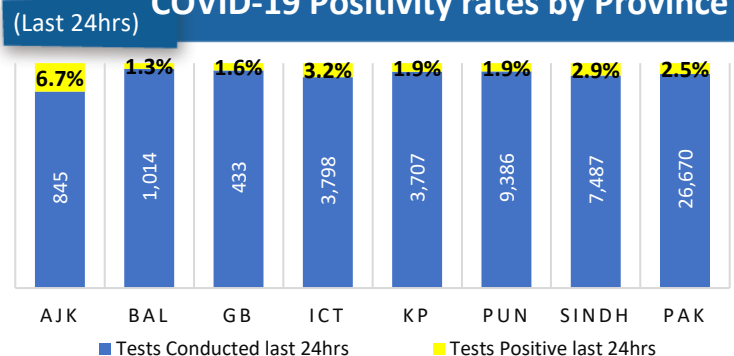
Daily Lab Tests conducted

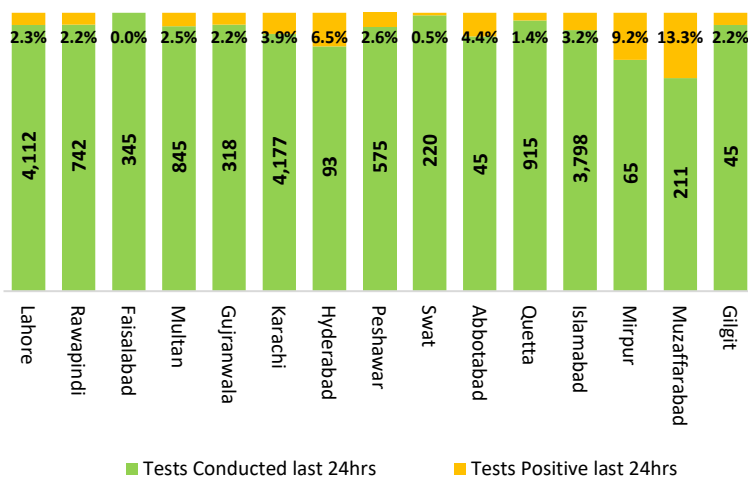
