




INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

28-Jul - 20-Dec 2020




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **1,792** new cases of COVID-19 on **20 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **458,968** with **9,392** deaths (**CFR: 2.05%**). Out of the total **40,491** currently active cases **2,925** cases are hospitalized.


MEETINGS & COORDINATION
