

Executive Summary


Pakistan reported 633 new cases of COVID-19 on 20 **September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 306,304 with 6,416 deaths (CFR: 2.09%). Out of the total 7,015 currently active cases, 837 cases are hospitalized, out of which 556 (66.42%) are in critical condition. 6,178 COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of 292,869 (95.61%) have recovered and discharged.

Daily Incidence/Mortality










Maintaining Essential Health Services

Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate




Daily COVID-19 Attack ratePer million population



Trends of COVID-19 confirmed cases








COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR

by Major Cities / Districts




Occupied COVID-19 ventilators
