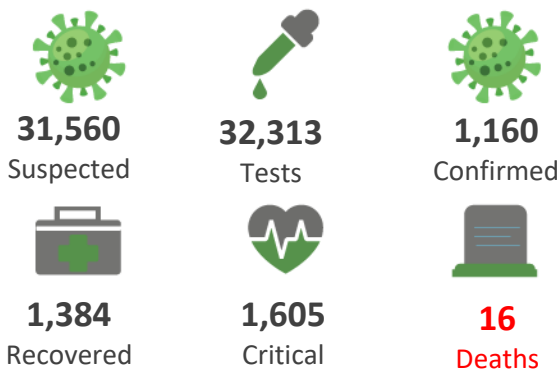


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



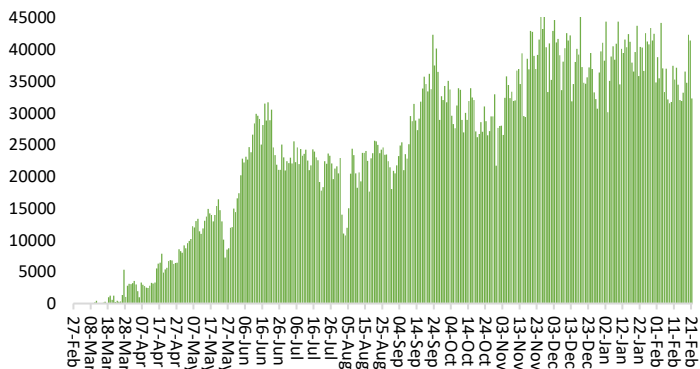
Pakistan reported **1,160** new cases of COVID-19 on **21st February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **572,334** with **12,617** deaths (CFR: **2.20%**). Out of the total **24,226** currently active cases **2,034** cases are hospitalized.

PAKISTAN UPDATES (Last 24hr)



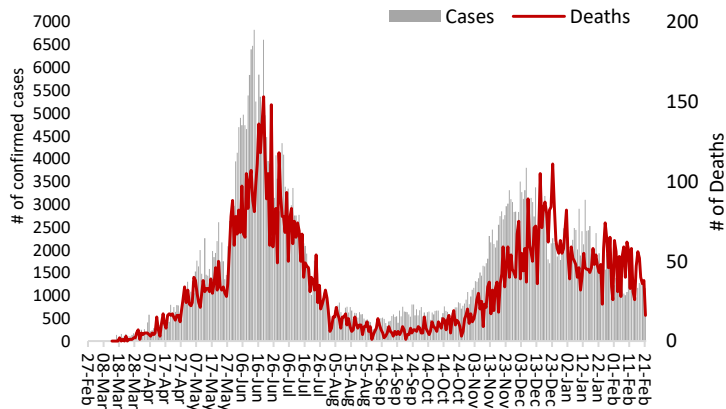
LAB TEST (PCR + RA) CONDUCTED BY DATE

26-Feb 2020 to 21-Feb 2021

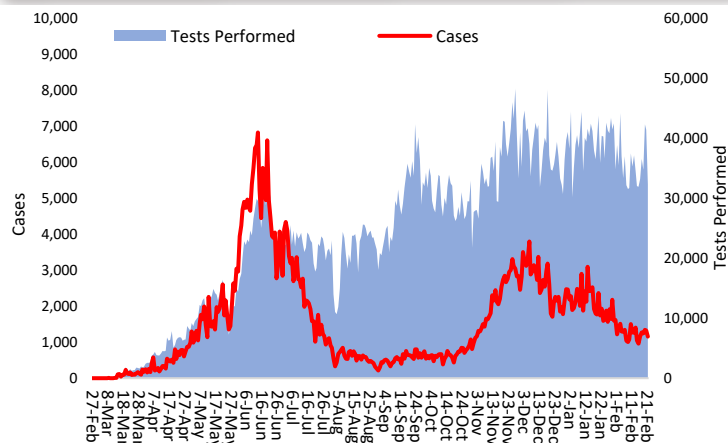


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 22nd February 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala donated over 15,000 COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Tests kits (capable of testing 375,000 samples) to the Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination (MoNHSR&C). The Chief Public Health Laboratories Division, National Institute of Health, Dr Muhammad Salman, and Director Central Health Establishment (CHE) Dr Shaista Habibullah received the donation on behalf of the MoNHSR&C. The aim of the donation is to strengthen COVID-19 surveillance at the Points of Entry (POE) in accordance with the new travel guidelines for Pakistan. During his address the WR applauded the government effort to control the spread of COVID-19 in Pakistan.

While receiving the donation Dr Salman and Dr Shaista expressed their gratitude to WHO for its continued support to Pakistan for COVID-19 Pandemic response.
