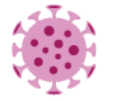

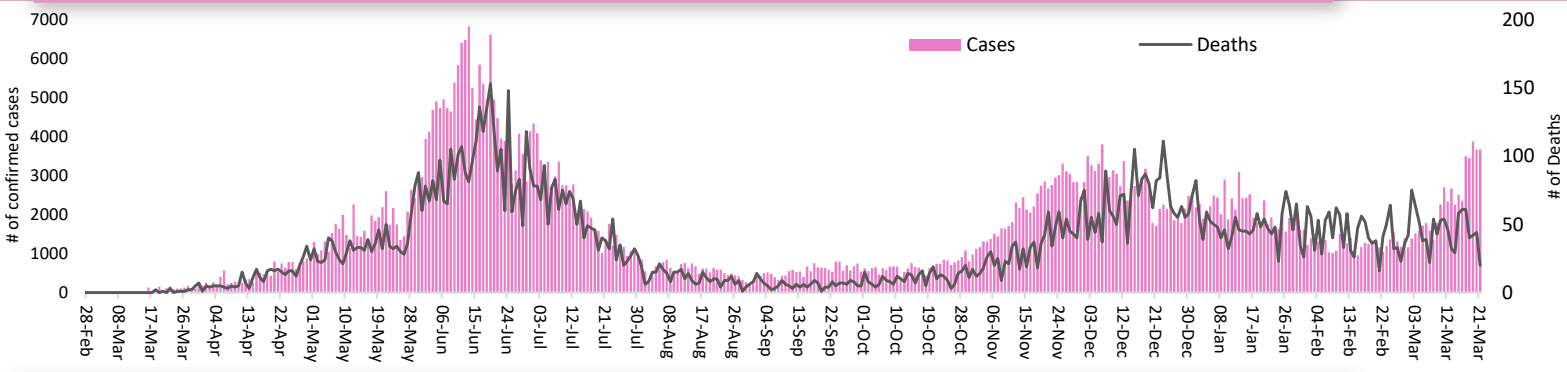

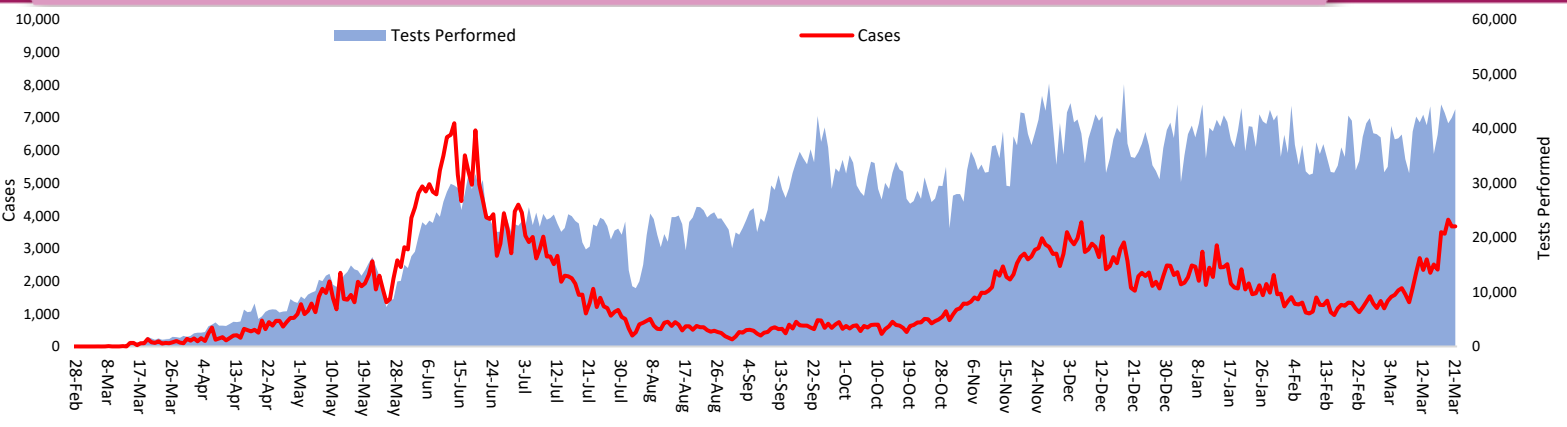

MEETING AND COORDINATION

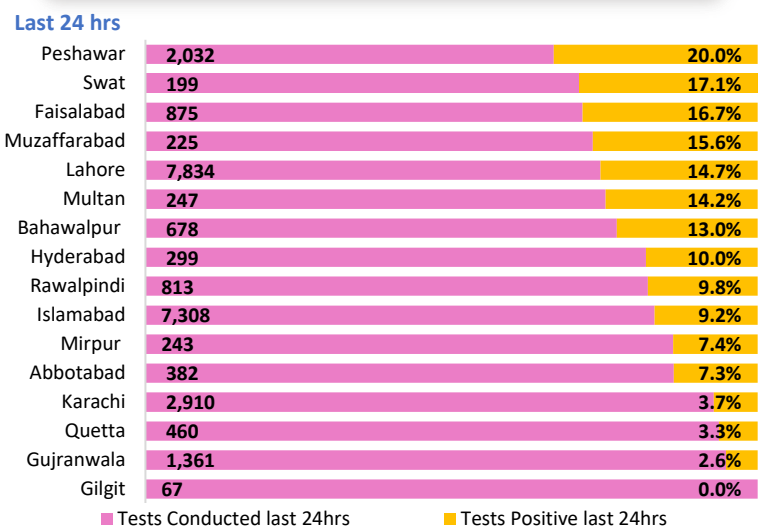

On 22nd March 2021, WHO Country office Pakistan conducted a virtual briefing for the development partners. WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala chaired the meeting. During the meeting, the WR briefed partners on the COVID-19 situation globally, in the Eastern Mediterranean Region and in Pakistan. He discussed the Government's strategy and response to control the spread of COVID-19 in the country. The WR also gave an overview of the COVID-19 cases and mortality pattern by the major cities and high risk districts, health system and response capacity in the country.

The WR thanked partners for their valuable support and contributions towards containing the COVID-19 outbreak. He requested partners to continue supporting the Government of Pakistan especially in the following areas: surveillance, vaccination rollout, laboratory, case management and risk communication and community engagement.
