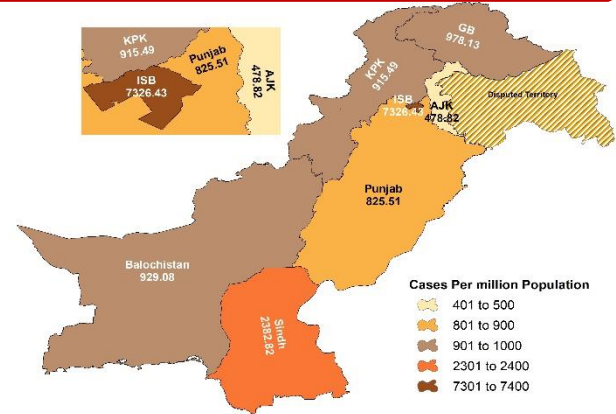

### COVID-19 case density/million Population

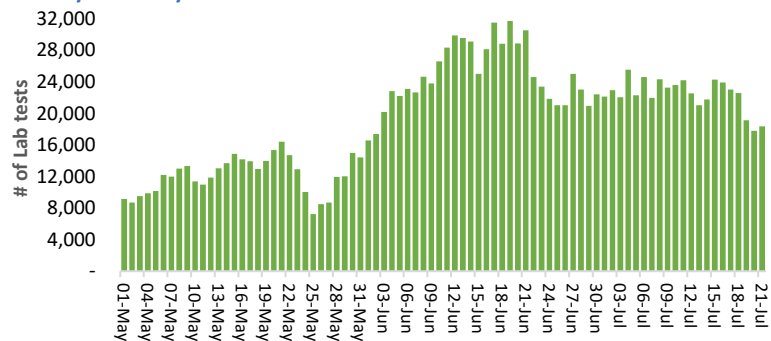


### Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **1,332** new cases of COVID-19 on **21 July 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **267,428** with **5,677** deaths (**CFR: 2.12%**). Out of the total **51,283** currently active cases, **2,394** cases are hospitalized, out of which **1,436 (59.98%)** are in critical condition. **48,889** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **210,468 (78.70%)** have recovered and discharged.

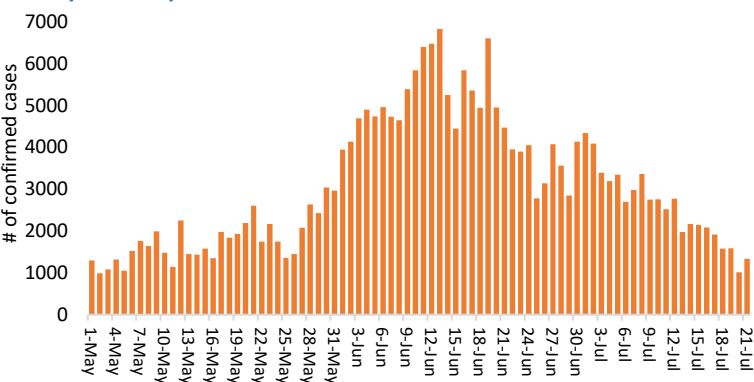
### Daily Lab tests conducted in Pakistan

01 May to 21 July 2020



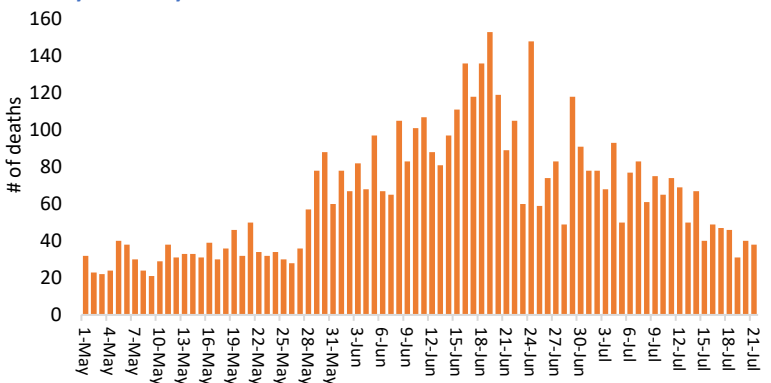
### Daily incidence of COVID-19 cases in Pakistan

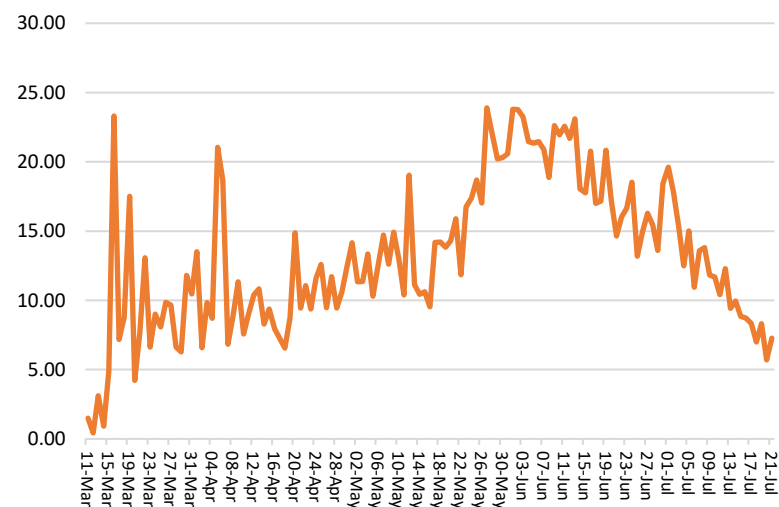

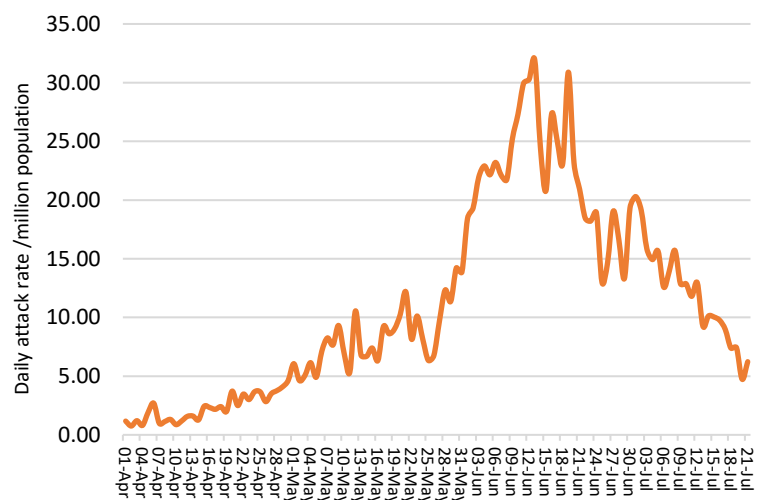
## Meeting & Coordination

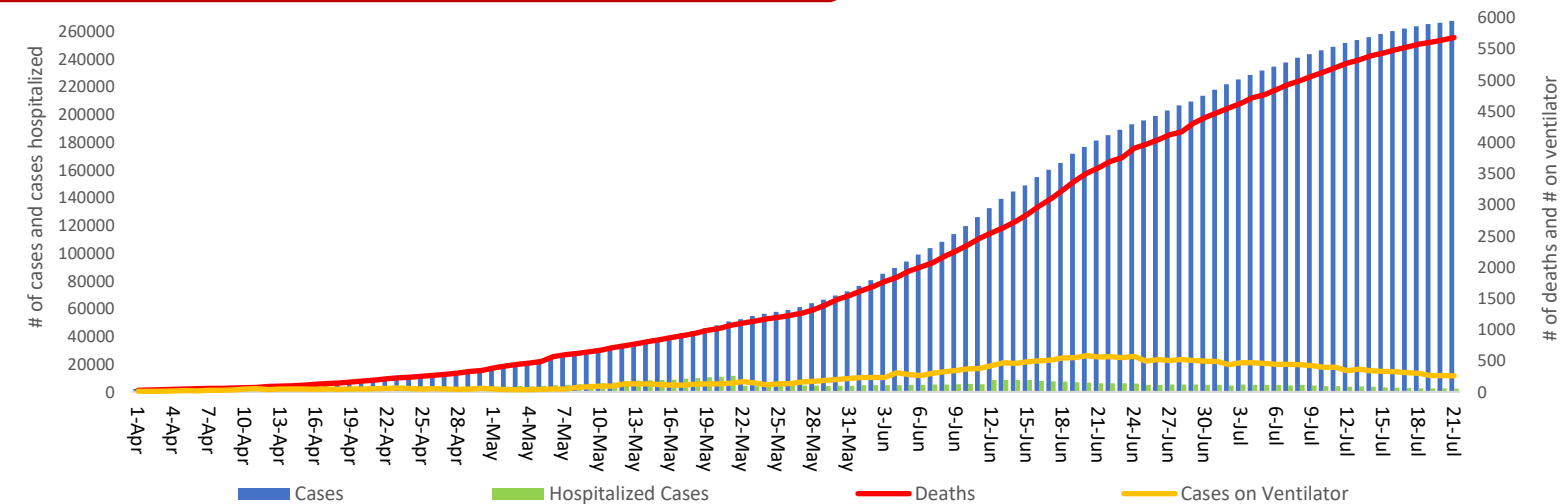
## Daily Positivity rate in Pakistan



## Daily Attack rate/million population



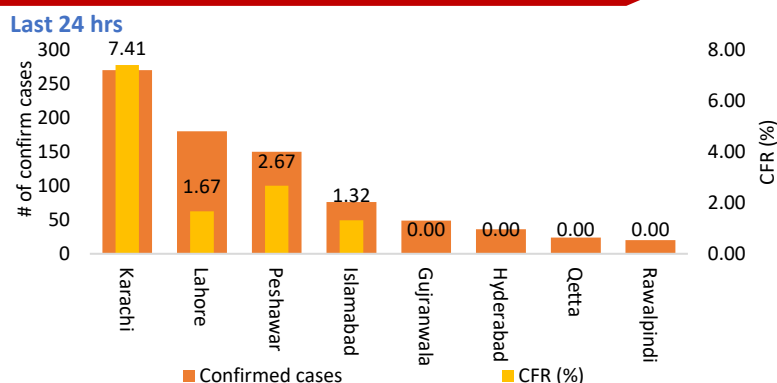
## Trends of COVID-19 cases, hospitalized, on ventilator & Deaths



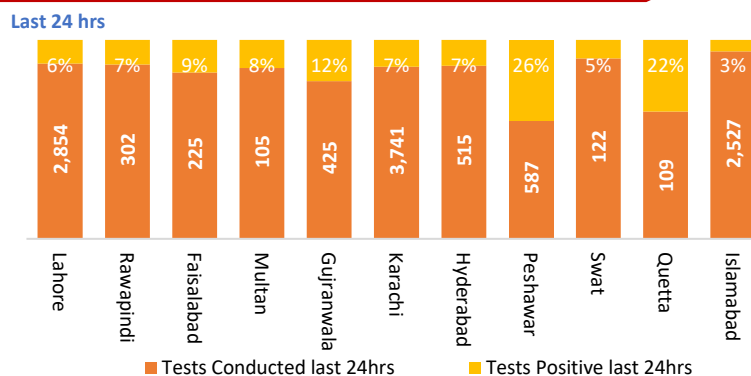

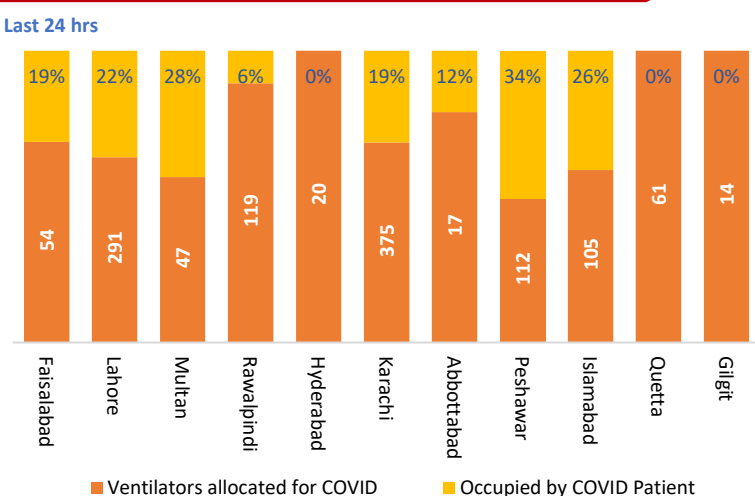
## COVID-19 confirmed cases & CFR (%) by districts
