




INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

28-Feb 2020 to 21 Feb 2021




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **1,050** new cases of COVID-19 on **22nd February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **573,384** with **12,658** deaths (**CFR: 2.21%**). Out of the total **24,483** currently active cases **2,069** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 22nd February 2021, the WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala met with Dr Hamid Jafari, Director Polio Eradication Programme in Eastern Mediterranean Region and his team. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss current challenges and opportunities of the polio eradication program, Pakistan. For the last one year, the EMRO polio team has been reviewing its current human resources setup in the Pakistan Polio Program as part of its transformation process. Last week, the polio eradication programme received feedback and recommendations from the Technical Advisory Group (TAG).

Dr. Palitha Mahipala thanked Dr Hamid and team for their hard-work and commitment for polio eradication, especially in view of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Dr Palitha also noted that Polio resources and infrastructure have been effectively supporting the COVID-19 response in various areas.
