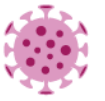

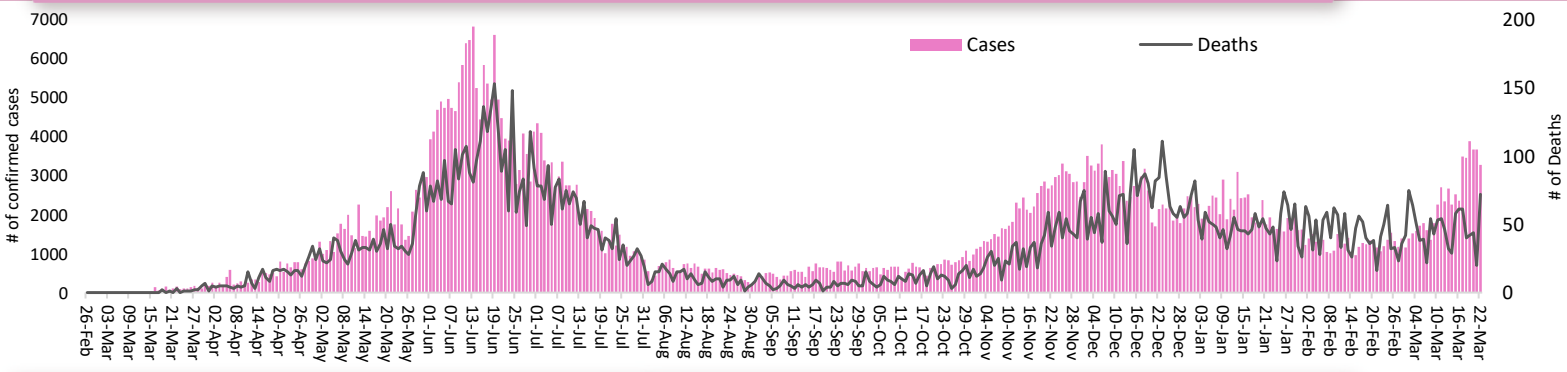

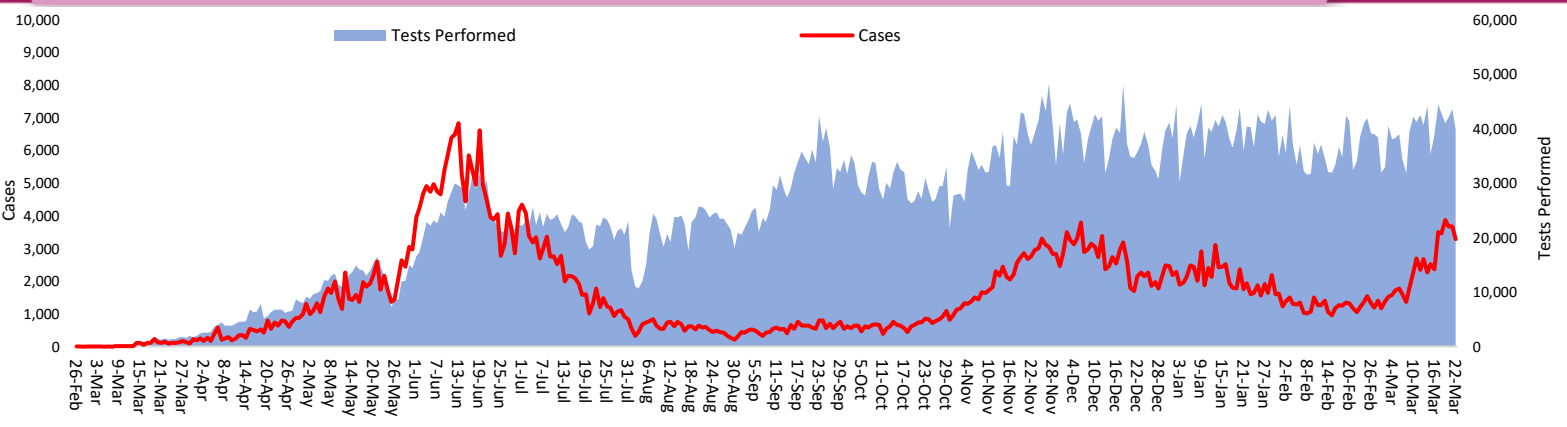

## MEETING AND COORDINATION

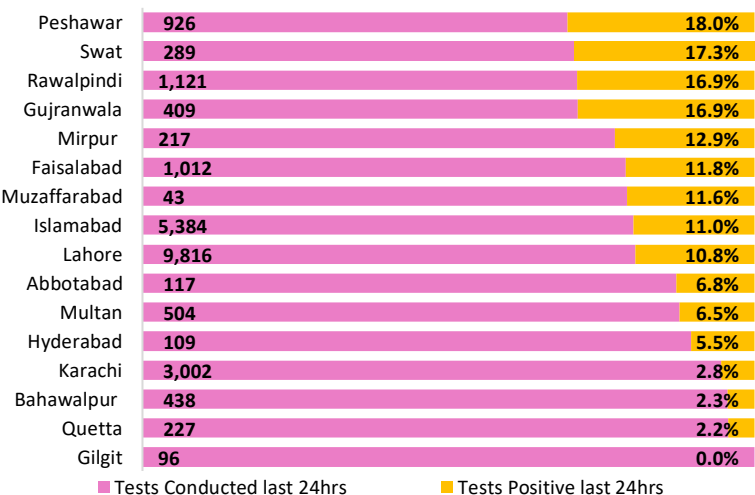
