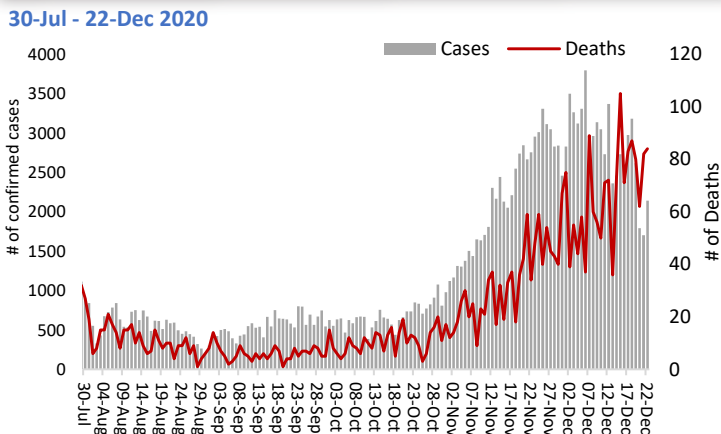

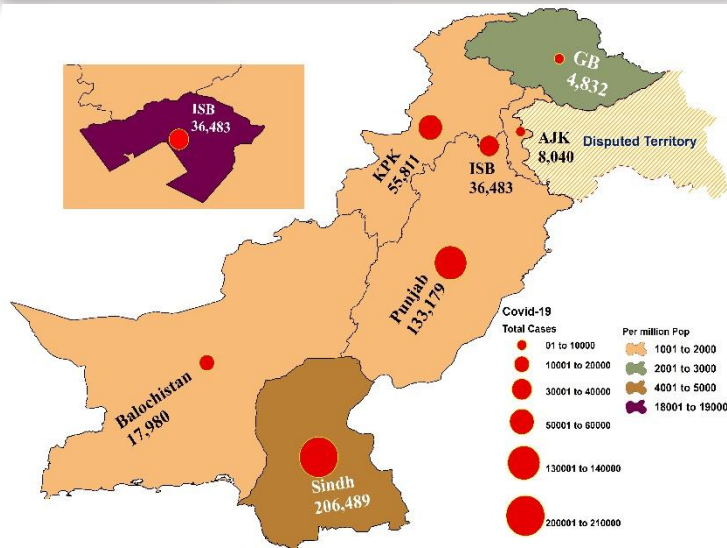

INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

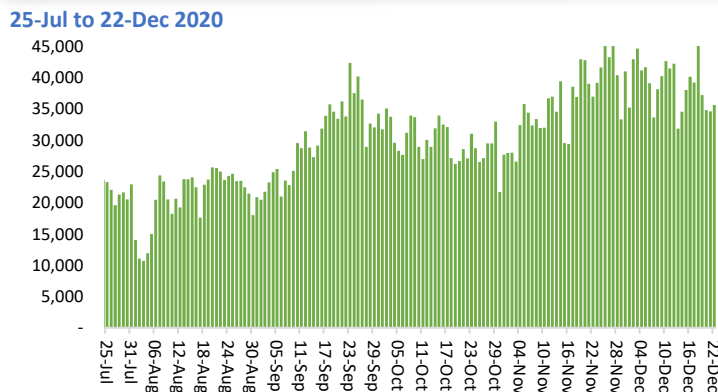


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.

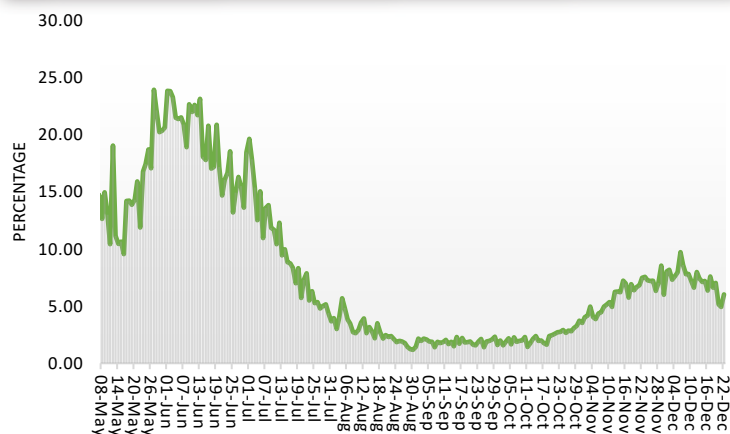


Pakistan reported **2,145** new cases of COVID-19 on **22 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **462,814** with **9,557** deaths (**CFR: 2.06%**). Out of the total **37,905** currently active cases **2,931** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

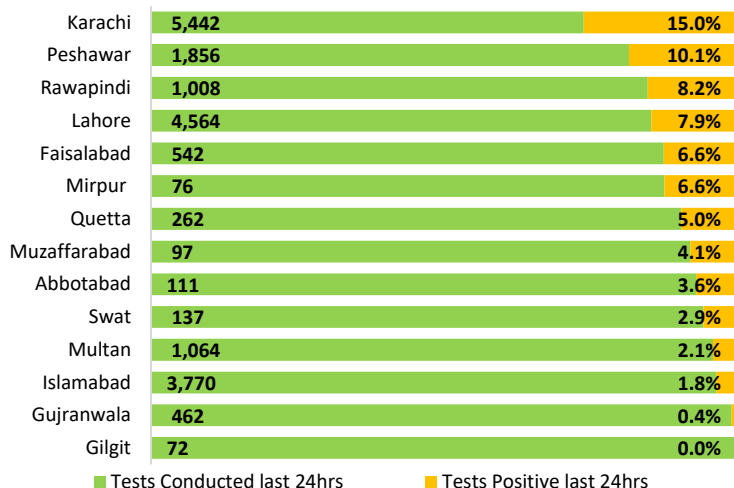
On 22nd December 2020, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala and WHO Balochistan Sub-Office team visited the Provincial Disease Surveillance and Response Unit (PDSRU) at the Directorate of Health Services Balochistan Quetta. The purpose of the visit was to review the surveillance setup specifically the Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (IDSR) system at the provincial level.

Senior officials at the Health Directorate welcomed WR at the PDSRU. The Technical Support Officer PDSRU, Dr Ehsan Larik briefed WR on the current status of IDSR implementation in Balochistan and appreciated WHO for its ongoing technical support. He also shared the plan for expansion of IDSR in 6 additional districts in the province.

WR appreciated the Department of Health and WHO surveillance team in Balochistan for their efforts towards establishing the provincial surveillance system. He assured the surveillance team of continuous technical support by WHO to strengthen the IDSR in the province.
