



#### **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




#### **TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.**




Pakistan reported **1,196** new cases of COVID-19 on **23**<sup>rd</sup> **February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **574,580** with **12,708** deaths **(CFR: 2.21%).** Out of the total **23,665** currently active cases **2,084** cases are hospitalized.

#### **MEETINGS & COORDINATION**

WHO Pakistan in collaboration with the department of Health Balochistan Province is conducting Health Resources and Services Availability Monitoring (HeRAMs) survey. The objective of the survey is to assess the availability of health resources (i.e. human resource, logistics, medical supplies, equipment, and health infrastructure); identify gaps and challenges in health service delivery and to prioritize health interventions. The survey is being conducted in all the health facilities in all the 33 districts of Balochistan. A standardized WHO survey tools are being used for data collection by officials nominated by the Government of Balochistan.

It is envisaged that findings from the survey will provide information for planning and strategy development for Balochistan province and all the 33 districts in Balochistan.
