


Meeting and Coordination




On 22nd May 2021 the office of the Director General Punjab Emergency Services (Rescue 1122), coordinated an awareness session on road safety in commemoration of the UN Global Road Safety Week (from 17th to 23rd May 2021).

The session that was held at the Governors' House, Punjab. The Special Advisor to Prime Minister (SAPM) on Health, Dr. Faisal Sultan who was the guest of honor; WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr. Palitha Mahipala; Governor Punjab, Chaudhary Muhammad Sarwar and Special Assistant to Prime Minister on Information and Broadcasting, Madam Firdous Ashiq Awan graced the occasion. The objective of the session is to promote road safety as enshrined in the UN Decade of Action for Road Safety 2021 – 2030.

Dr Palitha highlighted the importance of observing 30 km/hour speed limit in cities, towns, and villages to promote road safety for bikers and, WHO five strategic pillars of Road Safety to minimize the burden of disease due to road traffic accidents in Pakistan.
