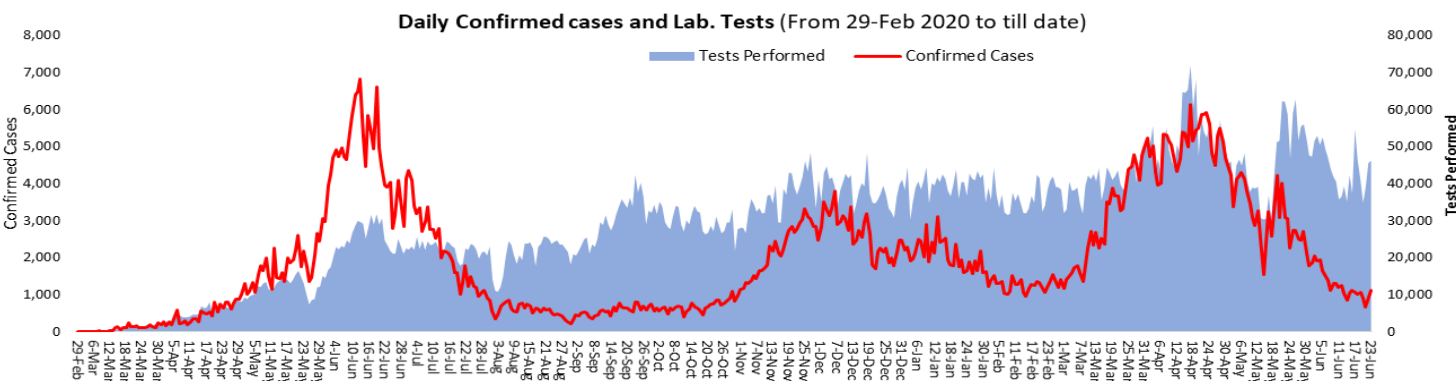

Meeting and Coordination



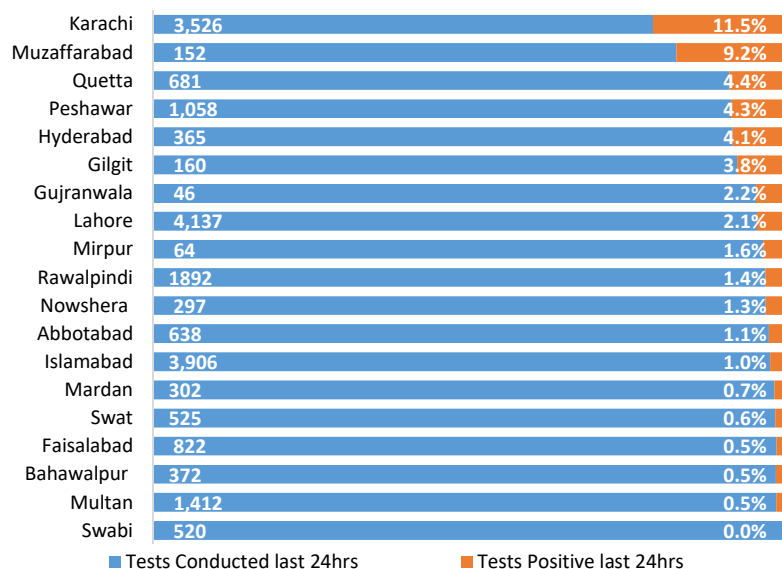
On 24th June 2021, WHO Country representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala accompanied by Expanded Program on Immunization (EPI) Team Leader, WHO, Dr Osama Mere and Head of WHO Sub-office Punjab, Dr Jamshaid Ahmed visited Jhelum district as part of technical support supervision to the ongoing Typhoid Conjugate Vaccination campaign. The team were received at CEO office Jhelum by the CEO Health, Dr Waseem Iqbal.

This campaign marks the formal introduction of typhoid conjugate vaccine into routine EPI schedule in Punjab. The campaign is targeting 6.6 million children aged 9 months to 15 years in 24 Districts of Punjab.

Dr Palitha visited vaccination outreach sites where he registered his satisfaction with the level of organization and appreciated the frontline health workers, parents and school administrators for their commitment and efforts to combat typhoid. He further, pledged WHO support towards this cause. The deputy Commissioner of Jhelum district attended the site debriefing.
