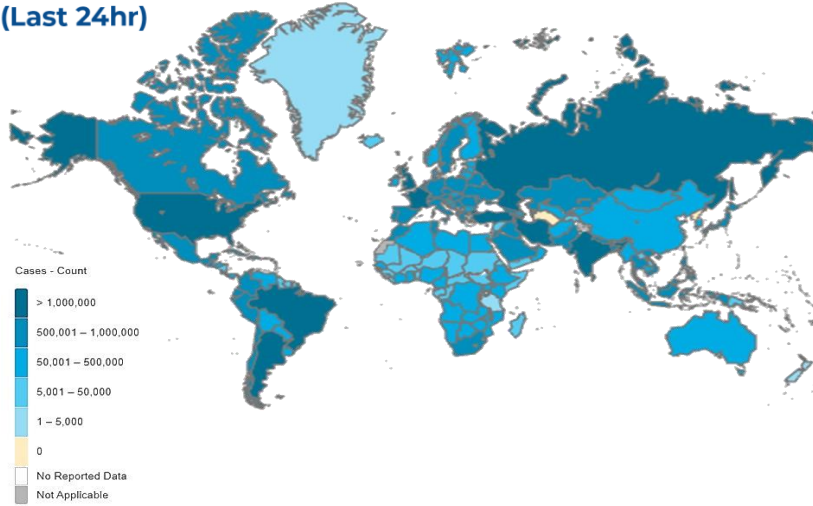
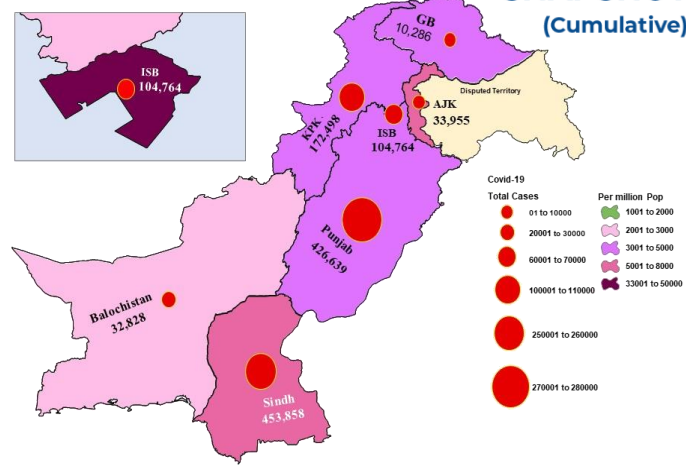

**PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)**



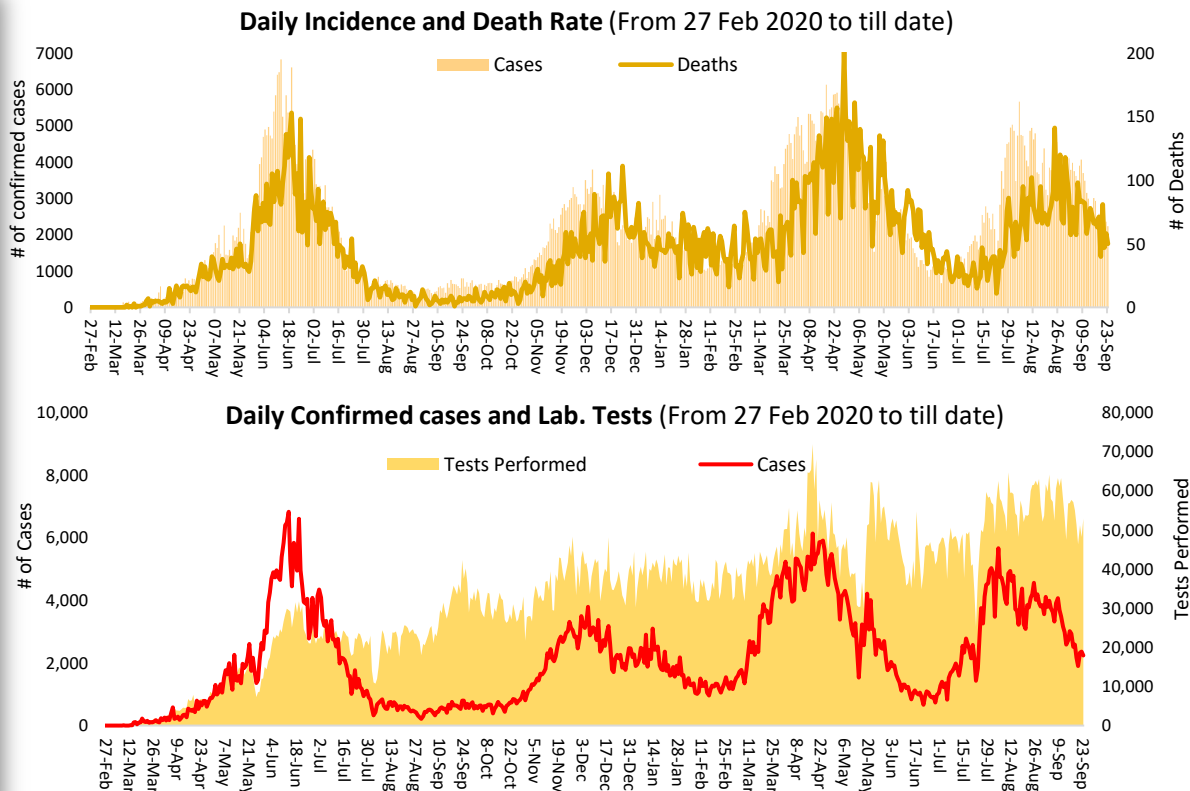

## Meetings & Coordination



On 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala visited Modal COVID-19 vaccination center at BHU Tarali, Islamabad. The purpose of the visit was to monitor the COVID-19 vaccination drive. The District Health Officer Islamabad Dr Zaeem Zia accompanied the WR.

The WR noted with appreciation the over 1 million doses administered per day and pledged WHO support towards the vaccination drive. He reiterated on need for vaccination of all vulnerable groups.

On the same day, Dr Palitha also supervised the door-to-door Polio vaccination campaign in the residential areas of Tarlai, Islamabad, where he participated in active vaccination of children at a local school. Dr Palitha appreciated Polio frontline health workers for their hard work and cautioned them to strictly adhere to COVID-19 SOPs.

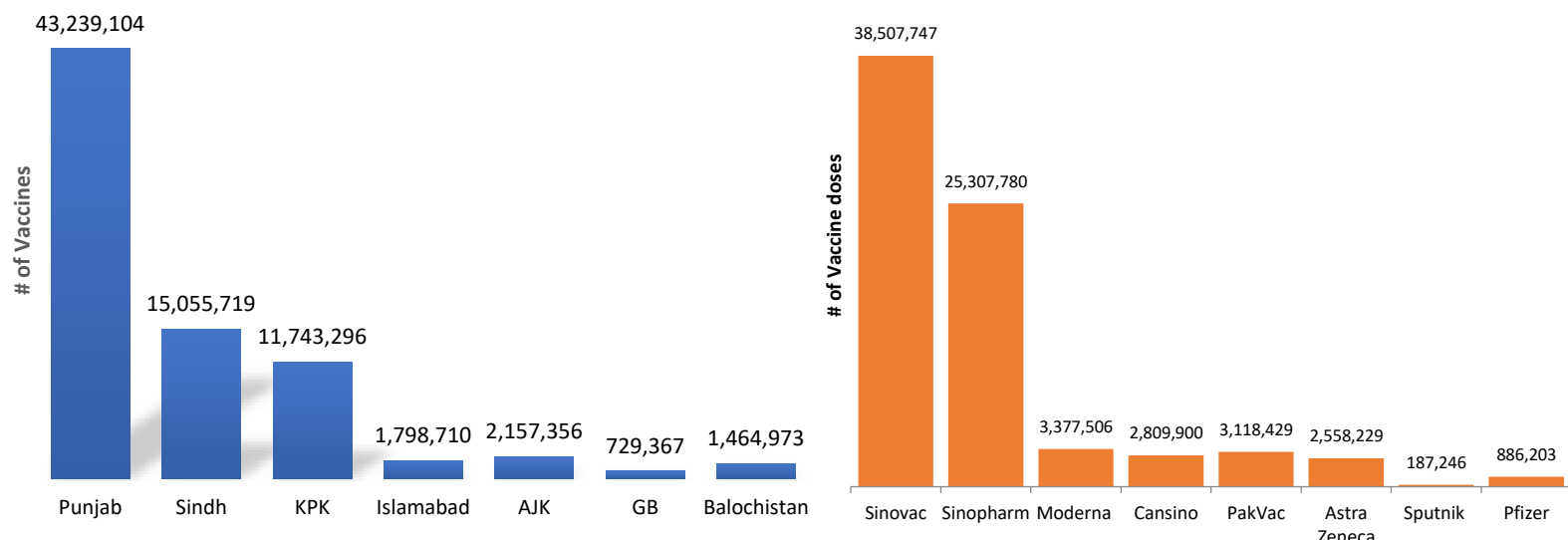

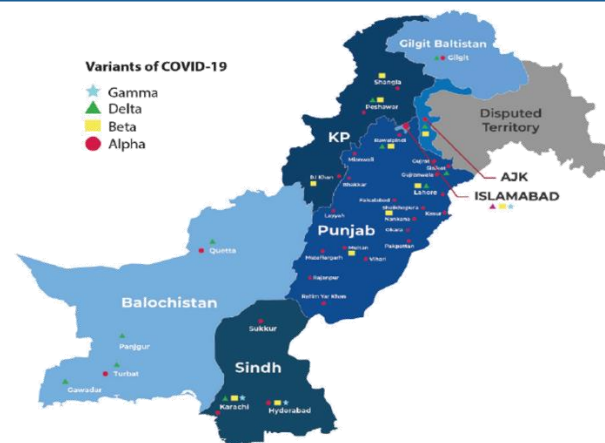
