On 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2021, WHO Regional Director for the Eastern Mediterranean Dr Ahmed Al-Mandhari along with WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala visited Allied school (outreach site) at Gulbahar Colony in Peshawar Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province. The purpose of the visit was to monitor the ongoing Nationwide Measles and Rubella campaign in Pakistan.

The campaign scheduled for 15<sup>th</sup> -27<sup>th</sup> November 2021 is targeting 90 million children of age range 9 months to 15 years and is the largest in Pakistan's history. Children Under 5 years of age are being administered polio Vaccine as well. In his remarks, Al-Mandhari congratulated the Government of Pakistan for executing the Measles and Rubella campaign. He applauded the front-line workers and the parents for supporting the campaign.
