





Pakistan reported **2,256** new cases of COVID-19 on **23 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **465,070** with **9,668** deaths **(CFR: 2.08%)**. Out of the total **38,268** currently active cases **2,878** cases are hospitalized.
