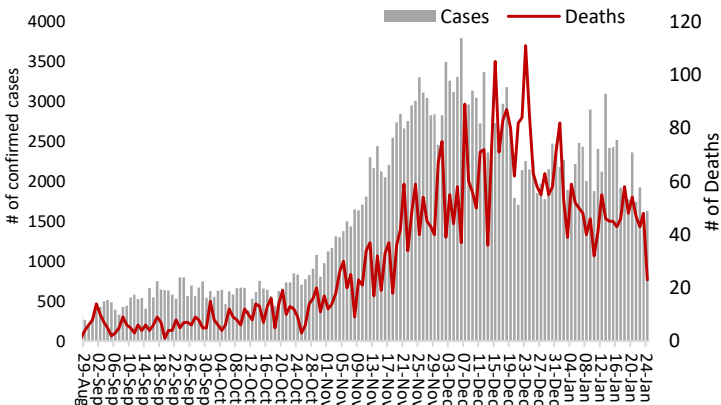

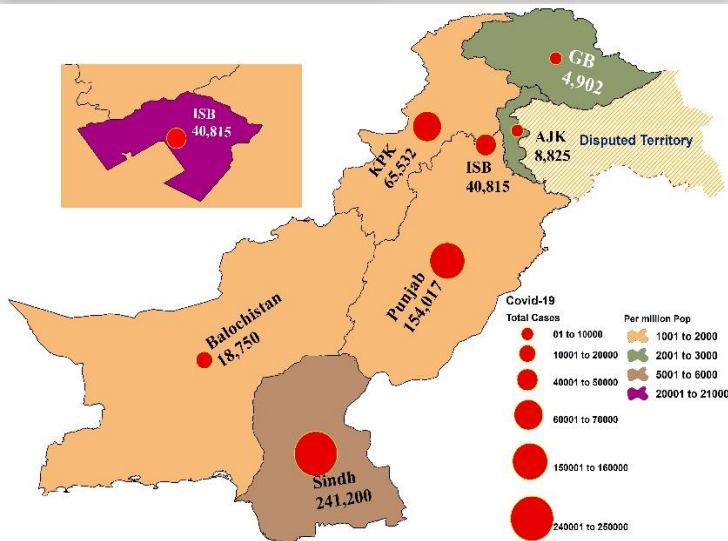


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

29-Aug 2020 - 24-Jan 2021



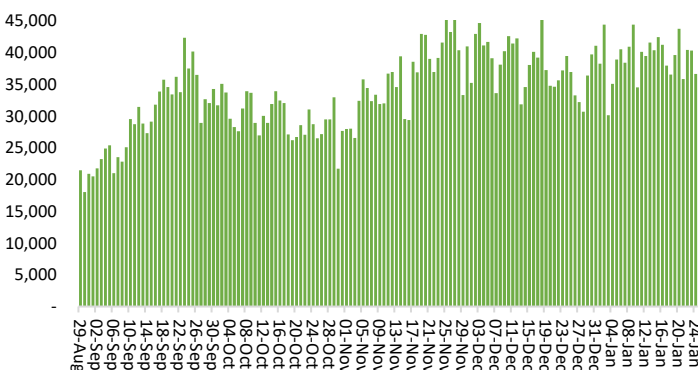
TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



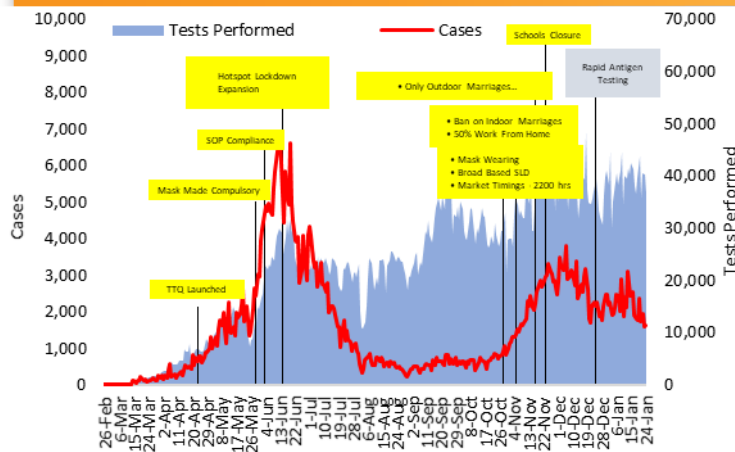
Pakistan reported **1,629** new cases of COVID-19 on **24 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **534,041** with **11,318** deaths (**CFR: 2.12%**). Out of the total **33,820** currently active cases **2,731** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 22nd January 2021, a WHO mission comprising of Dr Safdar Kamal Pasha NPO (HIV/Hepatitis) from WHO Country Office Islamabad and Dr Bader Munir (NPO RMCH) WHO Suboffice Sindh met with the Project Director Sindh AIDS Control Program (SACP). The objective of the meeting was to review the implementation of HIV Larkana Outbreak Response Plan. The project director appreciated WHO support for strengthening HIV Surveillance, Testing, Treatment, Infection Prevention & Control, hospital waste management, supply of Antiretrovirals (ARVs), diagnostic kits and CD4 machines. On behalf of Department of Health Sindh, the project director affirmed full commitment for a comprehensive HIV Response Stock-taking for the HIV Outbreak Response in Larkana. This activity is planned for later part of February 2021 with participation of all partners.
