



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **1,629** new cases of COVID-19 on **24** January **2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **534,041** with **11,318** deaths **(CFR: 2.12%).** Out of the total **33,820** currently active cases **2,731** cases are hospitalized.
