## Meeting and Coordination



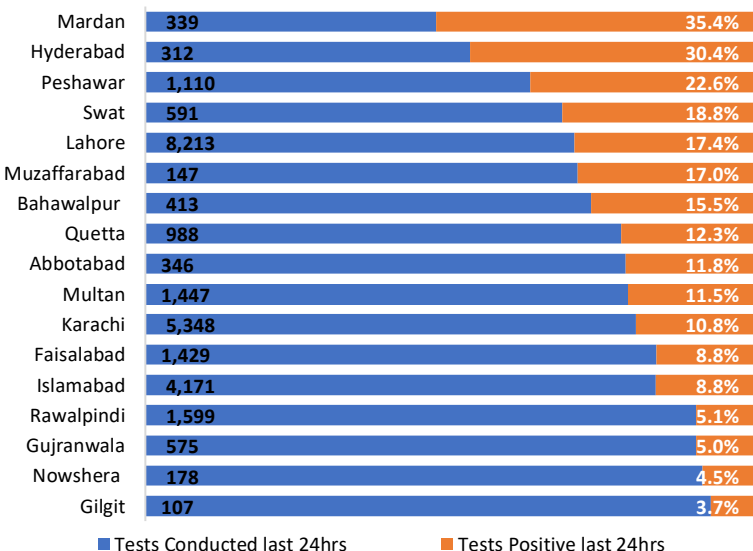
On 25th April 2021, Head of WHO Sub Office, Dr Asfandiyar Sherani, and WHO Surveillance Officer Dr Dawood Riaz participated in an emergency meeting at Balochistan Secretariate Office. The emergency meeting was called by the Provincial Secretary of Health, Balochistan Mr. Noor Ul Haq Balooch to discuss the increasing trend of COVID-19 cases in the province and review and update the response plan to control the 3rd Wave of COVID-19.

The meeting was attended by Medical Superintendents of Tertiary Care Hospitals, PCR Lab In charge, Dean Institute of Public Health, Balochistan, and members of the technical advisory group of Balochistan province.

During the meeting, the secretary of health Balochistan acknowledged WHO Pakistan for their effort in supporting the province to strengthening laboratory, case management, surveillance, COVID-19 vaccination drive, and maintenance of other essential health services.
