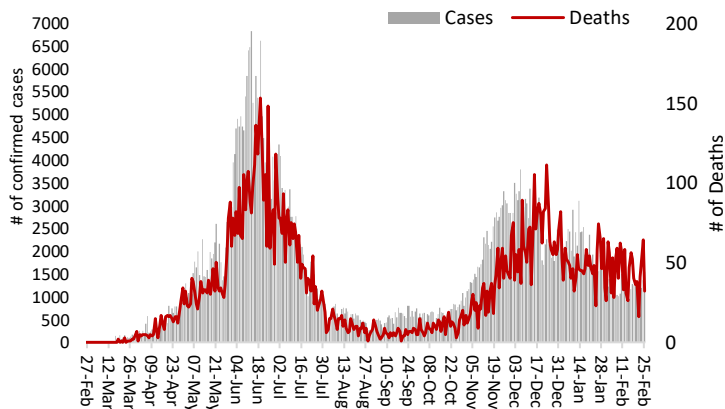

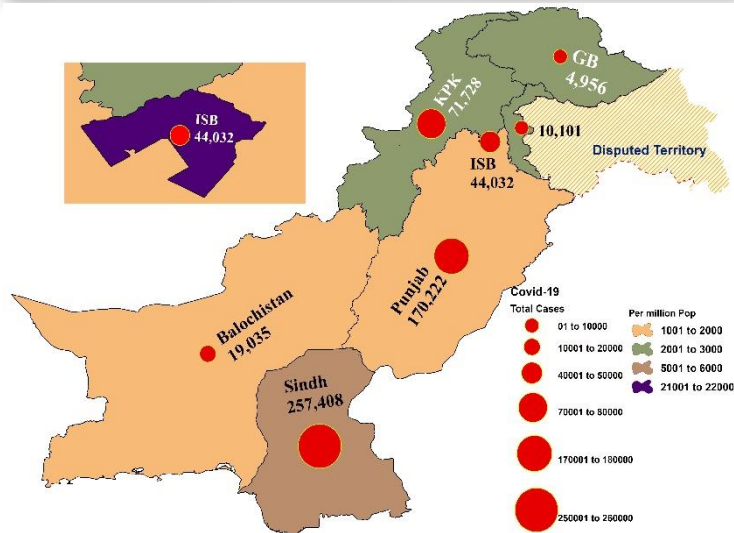


### INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

27-Feb 2020 to 25 Feb 2021



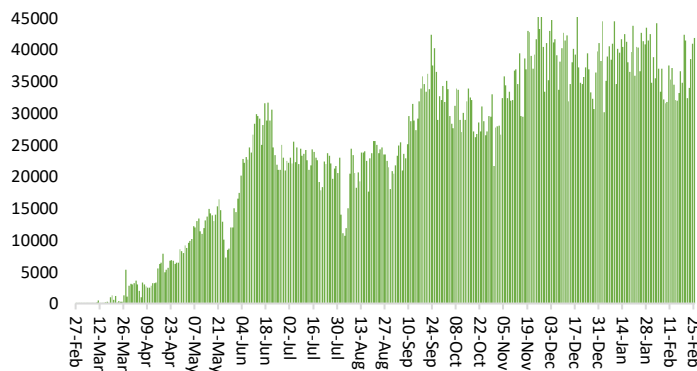
### TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



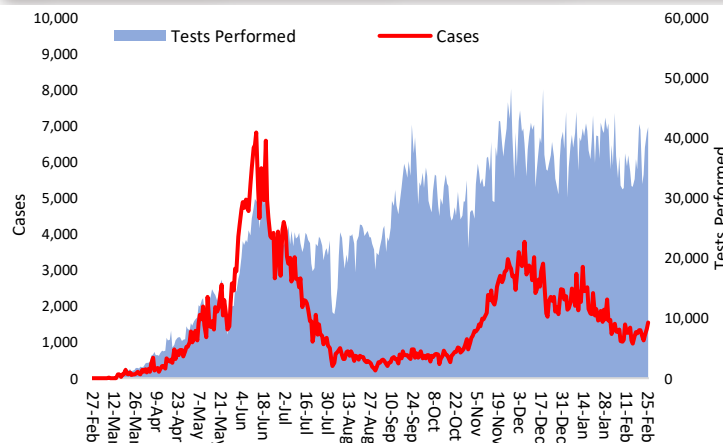
Pakistan reported **1,541** new cases of COVID-19 on **25<sup>th</sup> February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **577,482** with **12,804** deaths (**CFR: 2.22%**). Out of the total **22,285** currently active cases **2,018** cases are hospitalized.

## MEETINGS & COORDINATION

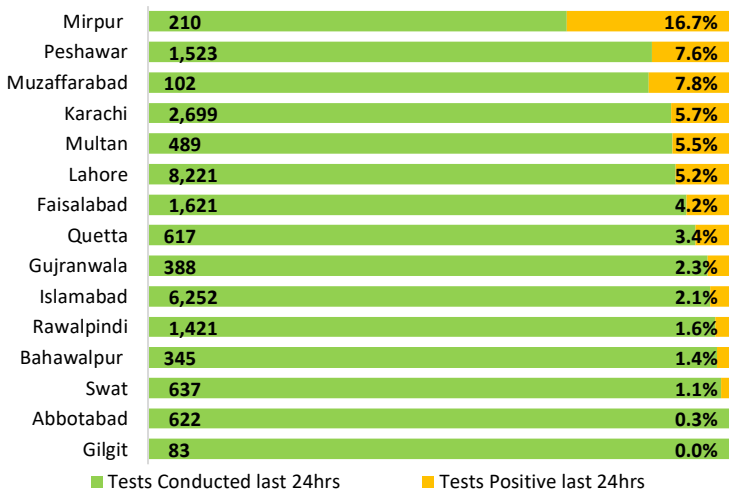
On 25<sup>th</sup> February 2021, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala donated 33 ambulances, 150 motorbikes, 12 double cabin vehicles and laboratory equipment on behalf of WHO to Honorable Special Assistant to Prime Minister H.E Dr Faisal Sultan.
