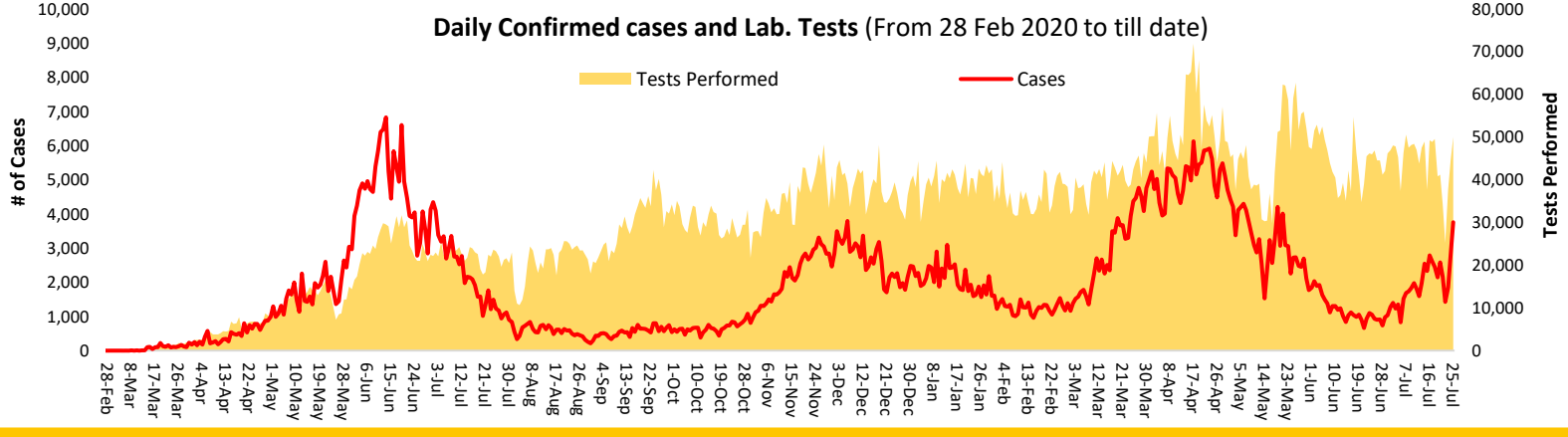

Meetings & Coordination



The Integrated Reproductive Maternal Newborn & Child Health & Nutrition (IRMNCH) Program, Punjab and Primary, and Secondary Healthcare Department Punjab in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan conducted a seven-day training on Pregnancy, Childbirth, Postpartum and Newborn care (PCPNC) at Nishtar Medical University Multan from 10-16 July 2021. The objective of the training was to build capacity of health care providers on early detect and effectively manage problems affecting mothers and newborns during pregnancy, childbirth, postnatal and neonatal period. 25 people selected from 9 priority districts attended the training.

The Closing session was attended by Secretary Health & Population Welfare department, South Punjab, Mr. Ajmal Bhatti, Additional Secretary, H&PWD South Punjab, Dr. Hafiz Shahid, DG Health South Punjab, Dr. Khalil Sakhani, Deputy Director IRMNCH&N South Punjab, Dr. Zuhaib Ali and Head of WHO Sub-Office Punjab, Dr. Jamshaid Ahmad.
