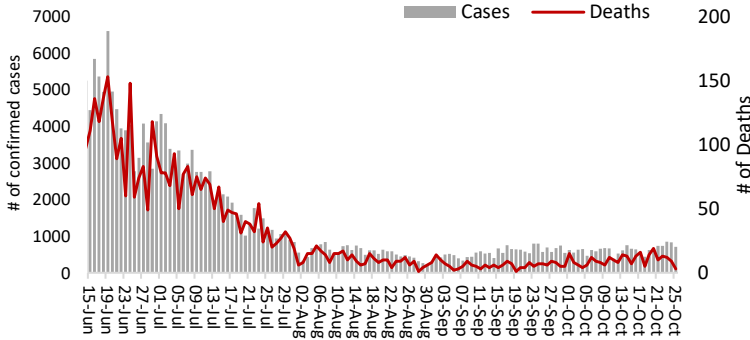

Executive Summary

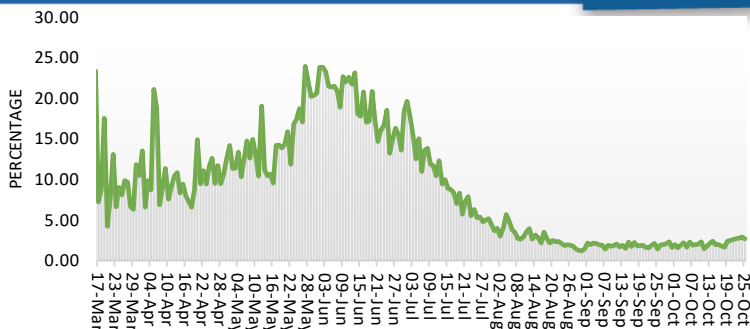
Pakistan reported **707** new cases of COVID-19 on **25 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **328,602** with **6,739** deaths (**CFR: 2.05%**). Out of the total **10,668** currently active cases, **834** cases are hospitalized, out of which **562 (67.39%)** are in critical condition. **10,788** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **311,075 (94.66%)** have recovered and discharged.

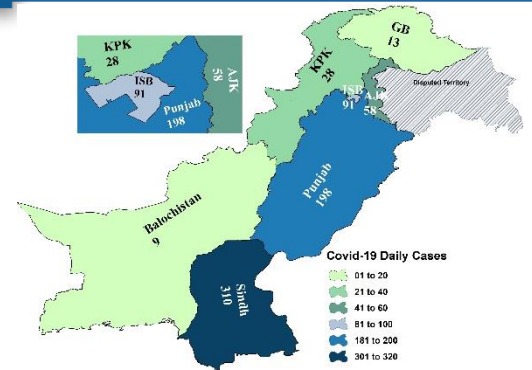

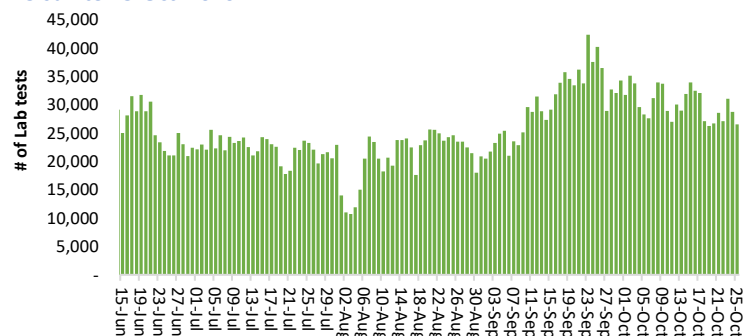

Daily Incidence by Province



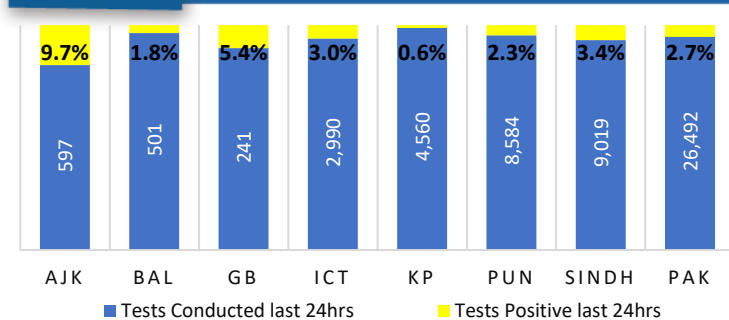

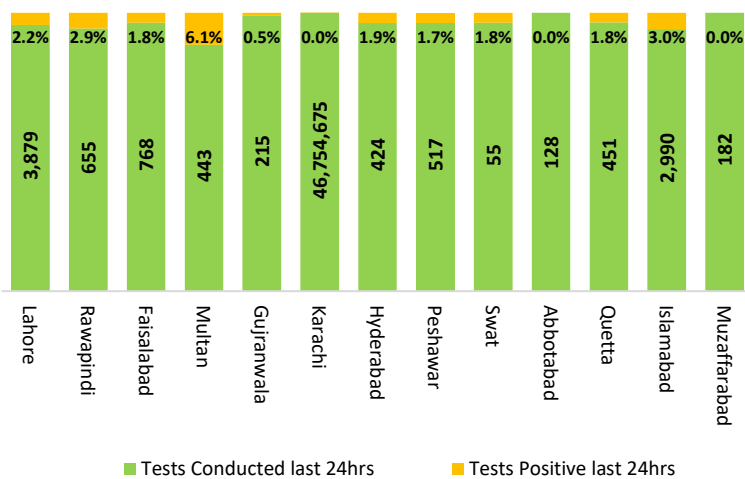
