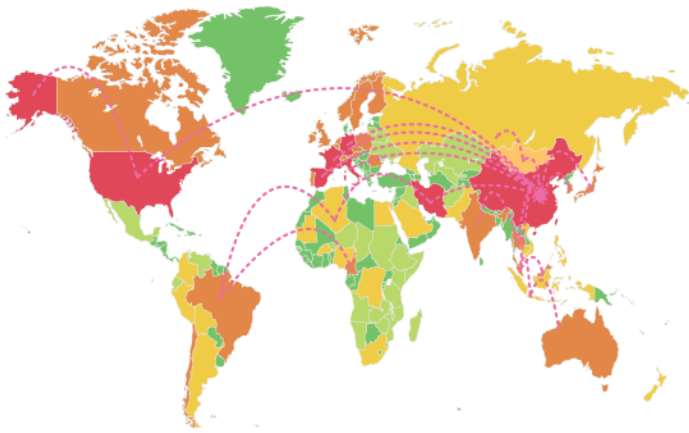








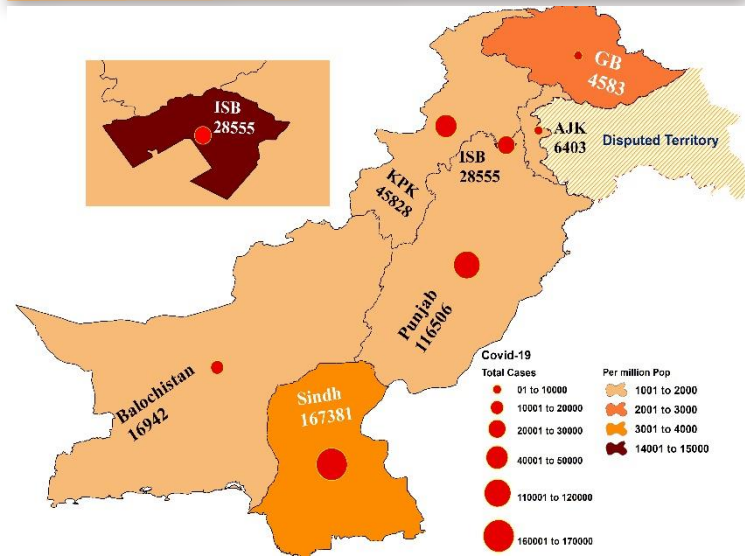

### TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.

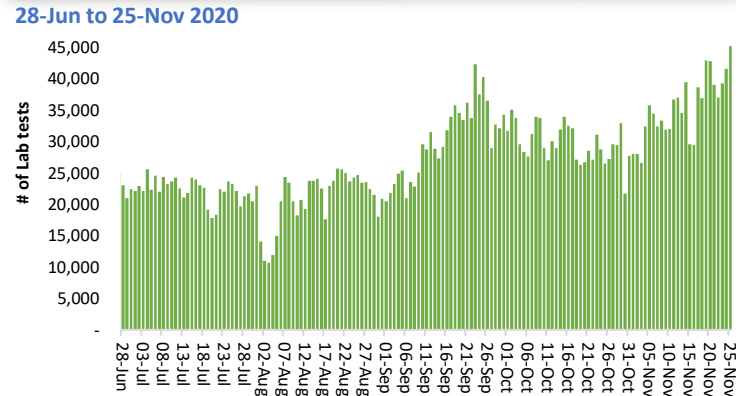


Pakistan reported **3,306** new cases of COVID-19 on **25 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **386,198** with **7,843** deaths (CFR: **2.03%**). Out of the total **43,965** currently active cases, **2,485** cases are hospitalized.

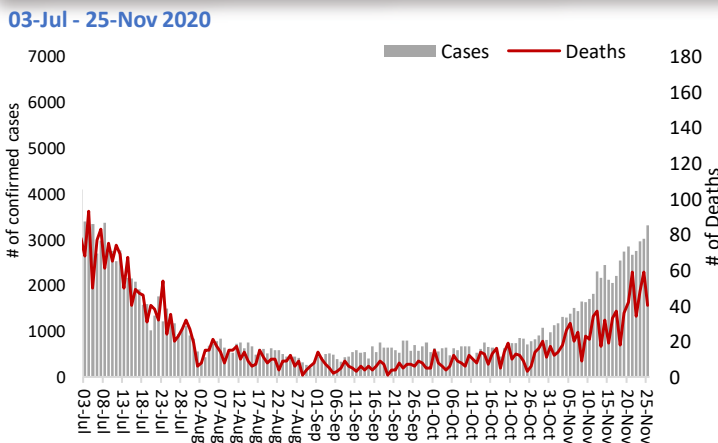

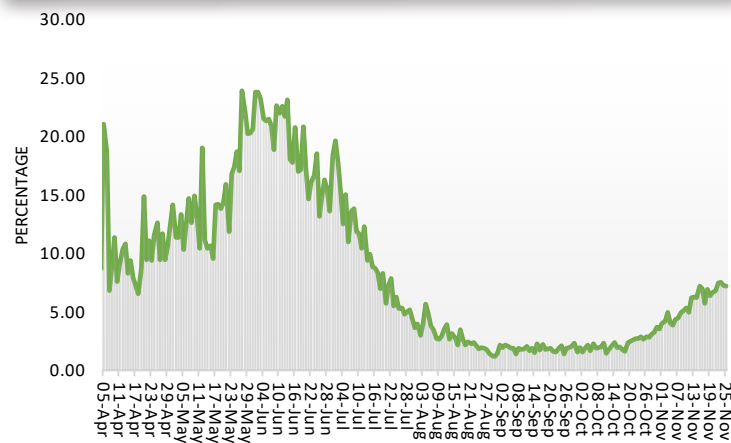
### LAB TEST CONDUCTED BY DATE

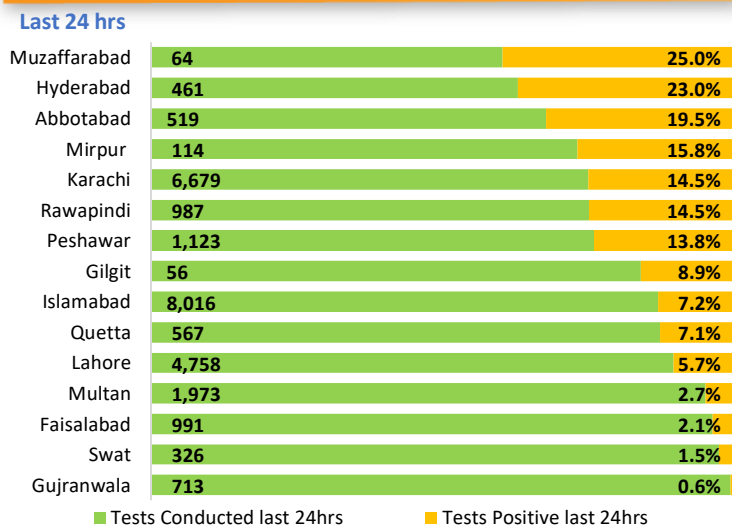
