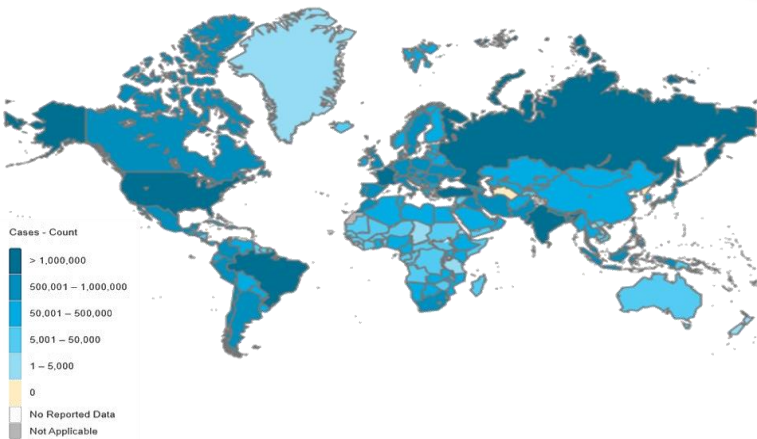


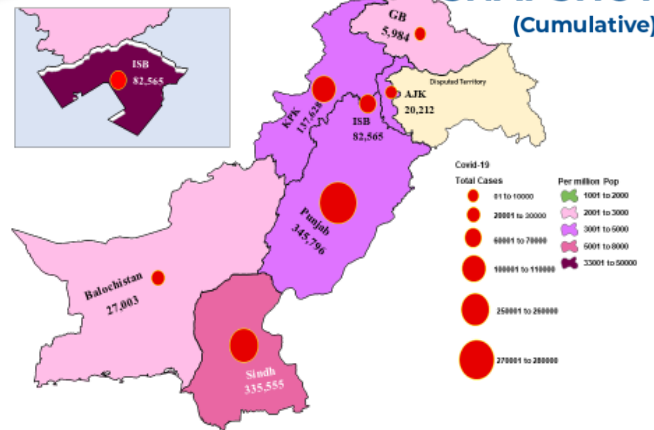

## PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

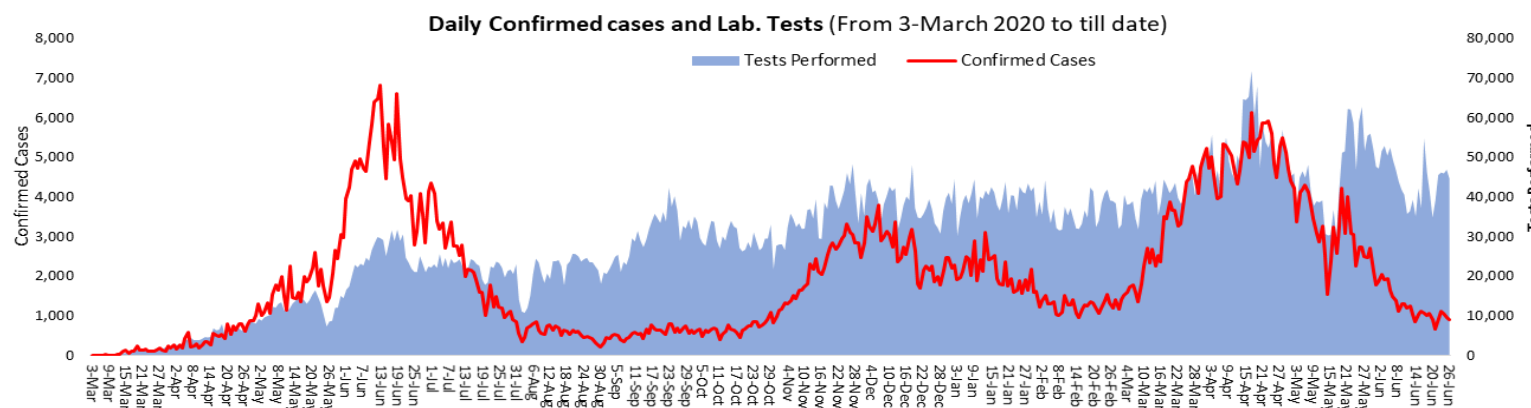
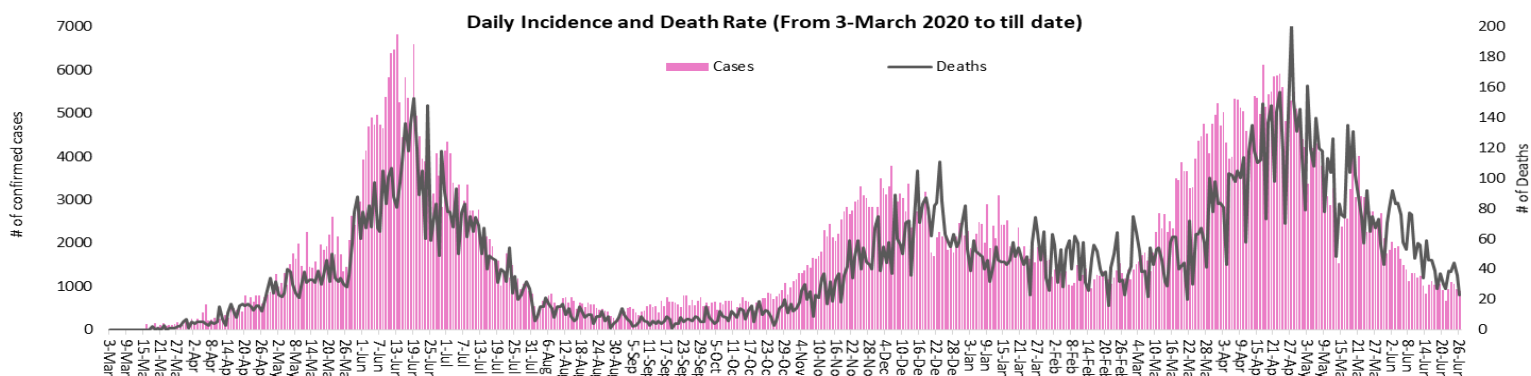

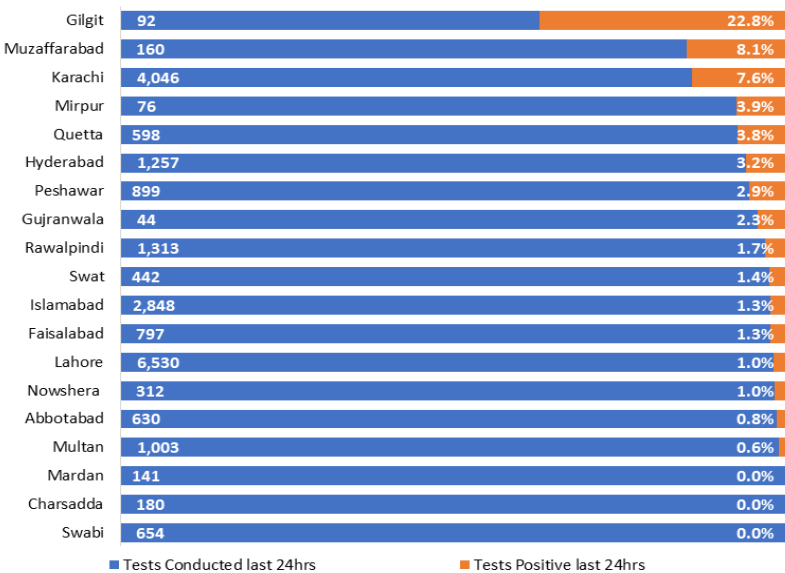
## Meeting and Coordination



The World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Provincial Department of Health Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and National Institute of Health Islamabad conducted a three days training (from 23-26 June 2021) for the 2nd batch of health care provider on implementation of Integrated Disease Surveillance Response (IDSR) in district Swat. The purpose of this training was to strengthen disease surveillance in the district. 45 health care providers from the health facilities attended the training. Dr Muhammad Niaz Khan, Director General Health Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, graced the closing session. In his remarks the Director General Health appreciated the health care workers for their dedication and participation in the training and encouraged them to apply the knowledge learned during the training in the district.
