## Meetings & Coordination



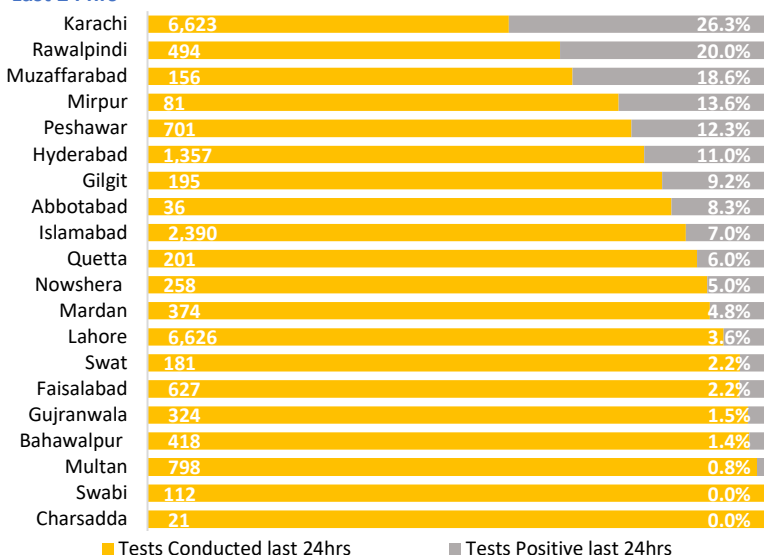
On 15 July 2021, World Health Organization, Pakistan supported the dissemination of Third-Party Verification Immunization Coverage Survey (TPVICS) 2019 findings in Pakistan. Special Assistant to Prime Minister for Health, Dr Faisal Sultan presided over as the Chief Guest of the event. The survey report indicated 83.5% coverage for Penta 3 among children under one year in Pakistan representing 9% increase as compared to 2017.

Speaking on the occasion Dr Faisal Sultan applauded the front-line vaccinators for their role in improvement of childhood immunization coverage and emphasized that the same level of dedication and commitment is required until the last child is vaccinated.

WHO team lead for EPI, Dr Osama Mere attended the event on behalf of WHO WR Pakistan, he appreciated the Government for the improved performance and emphasized on the need to build on this routine immunization coverage to ensure no child dies from the vaccine - preventable diseases (VPDs).
