



Pakistan reported **1,853** new cases of COVID-19 on **26 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **471,335** with **9,874** deaths **(CFR: 2.09%)**. Out of the total **39,329** currently active cases **2,784** cases are hospitalized.

The World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Punjab Healthcare Commission (PHC) conducted one day training on 'Clinical Case Management of COVID-19 patients at Bahria International Hospital Lahore.
