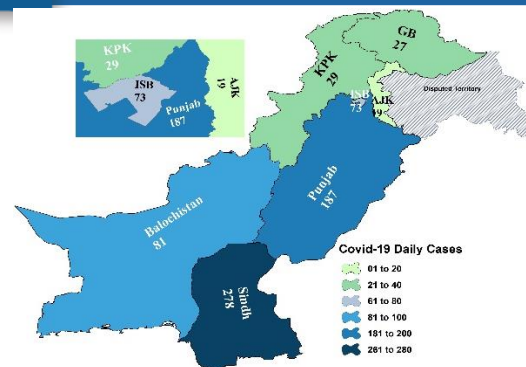

Executive Summary

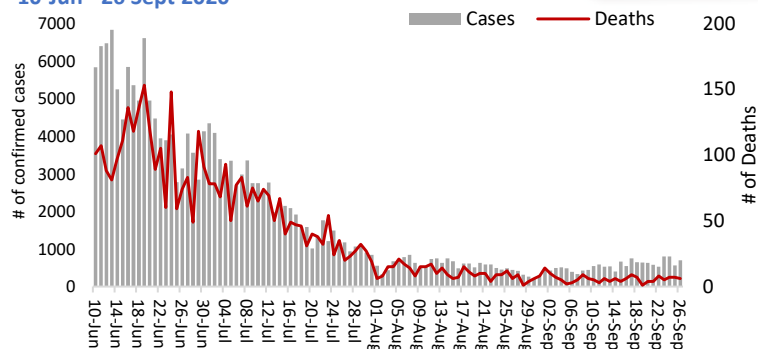
Pakistan reported **566** new cases of COVID-19 on **26 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **310,275** with **6,457** deaths (CFR: **2.08%**). Out of the total **8,205** currently active cases, **924** cases are hospitalized, out of which **584 (63.20%)** are in critical condition. **7,281** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **295,613 (95.27%)** have recovered and discharged.

Daily Incidence by Province



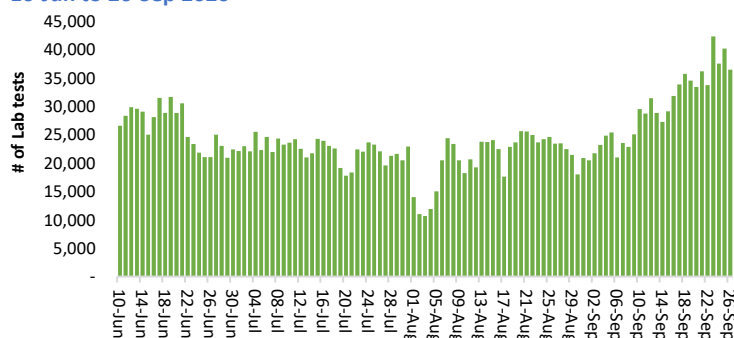
Daily Incidence/Mortality

10-Jun - 26 Sept 2020

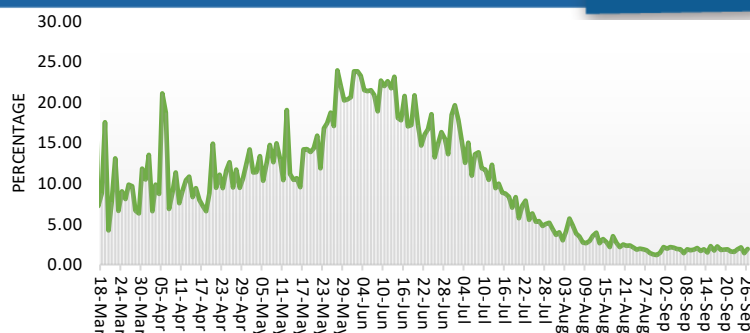


Daily Lab Test conducted

10-Jun to 26-Sep 2020

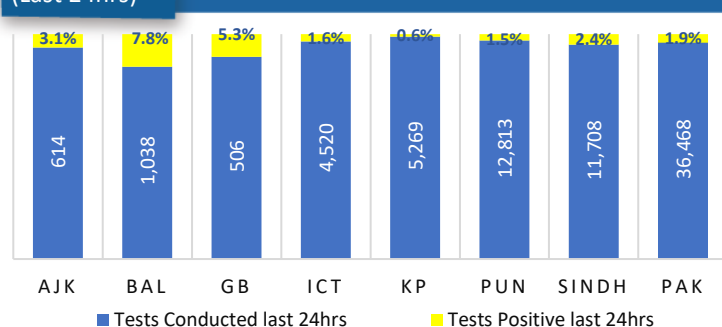


Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate

Capacity building of the laboratories

In response to the request by the Health Department, Government of Balochistan, the WHO Country Office Pakistan, in collaboration with the National Institute of Health, Islamabad visited public health laboratory at Fatima Jinnah Chest and General Hospital, Quetta and Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Federal Hospital Quetta on 26th – 27th September 2020. The objective of visit is to provide onsite technical support and capacity building of the provincial public health laboratory staff.

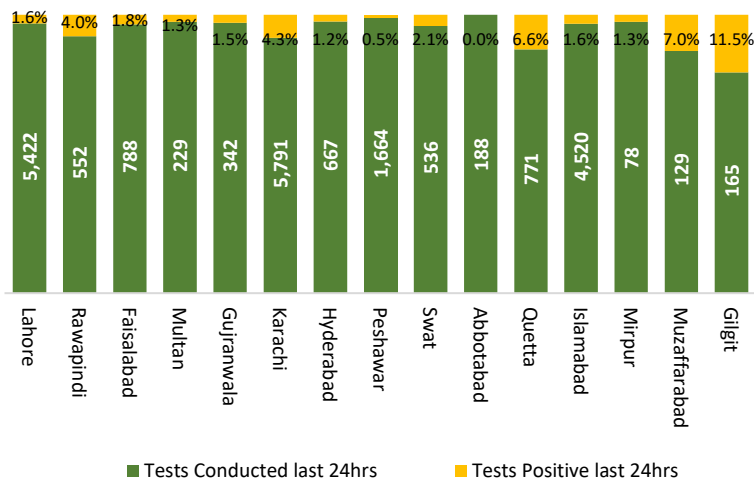
