

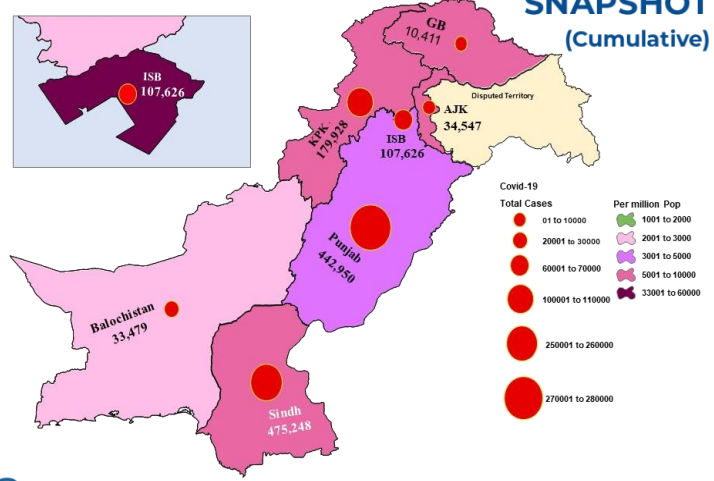

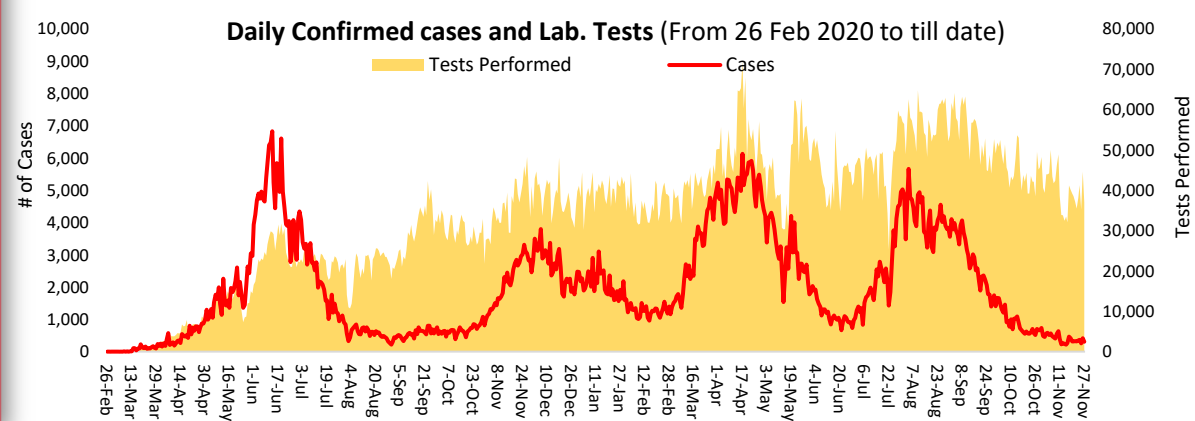
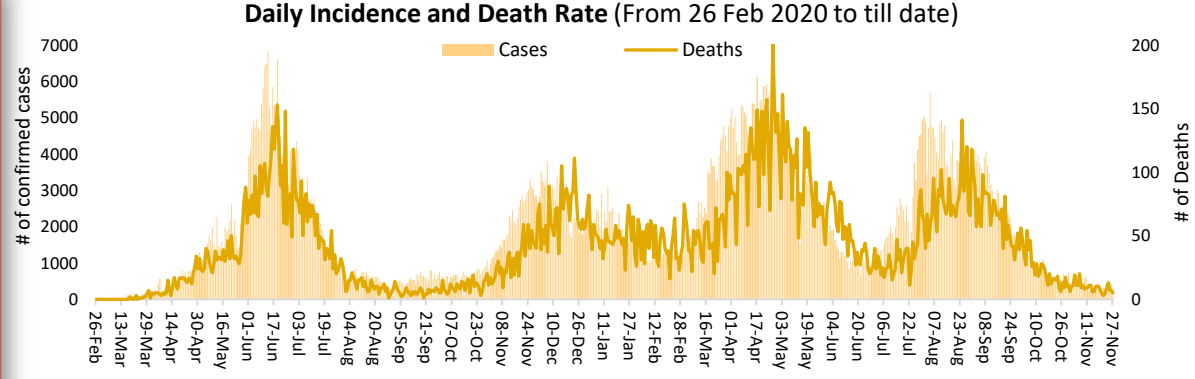

Provincial Department of Health, Sindh in collaboration with People’s University of Medical & Health Sciences (PUMHS), Nawab Shah and World Health Organization Pakistan conducted Early Essential Newborn Care (EENC) training at PUMHS, Nawab shah from 24th to 26th November 2021. 20 participants comprising of Obstetricians, Pediatricians, Neonatologists, Labor room in charge, IPC focal person and deputy medical superintendent attended the training. The opening and closing ceremonies were graced by the Pro Vice Chancellor Dr Farida Wagon, Medical Superintendent Dr Yar Muhammad Jamali. During the training, participated audited hospital service delivery data recorded over 5 years. Dr Farida appreciated WHO efforts in ensuring internal identification and rectification of gaps. Dr Yar Muhammad Jamali reiterated the commitment of the hospital to implement WHO guidelines on EENC.
