

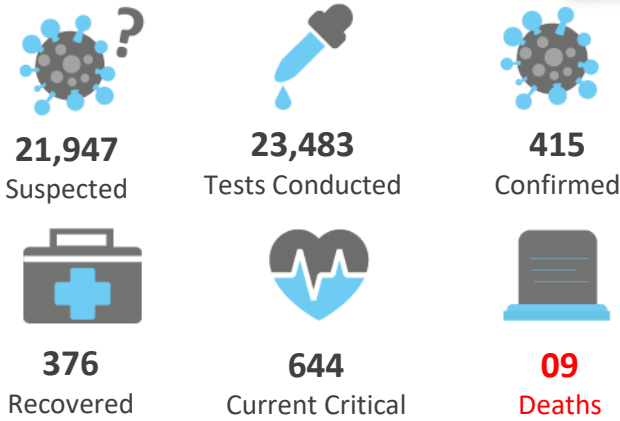

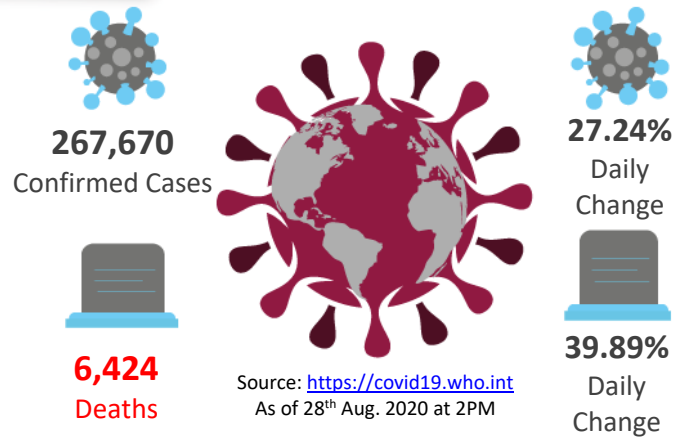

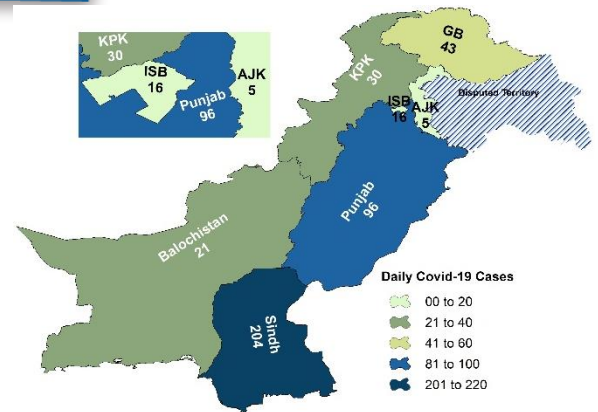

Executive Summary

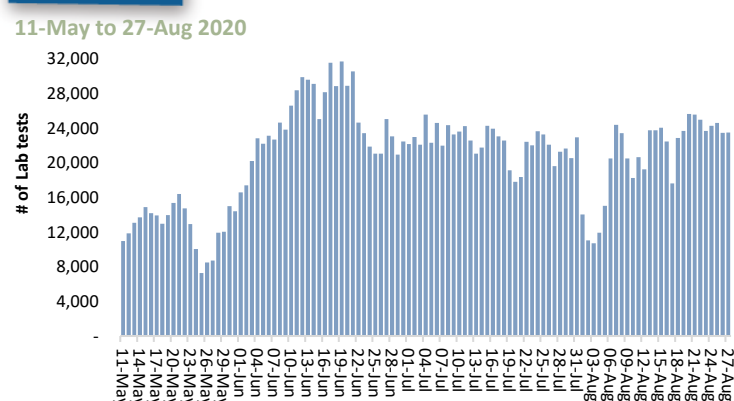
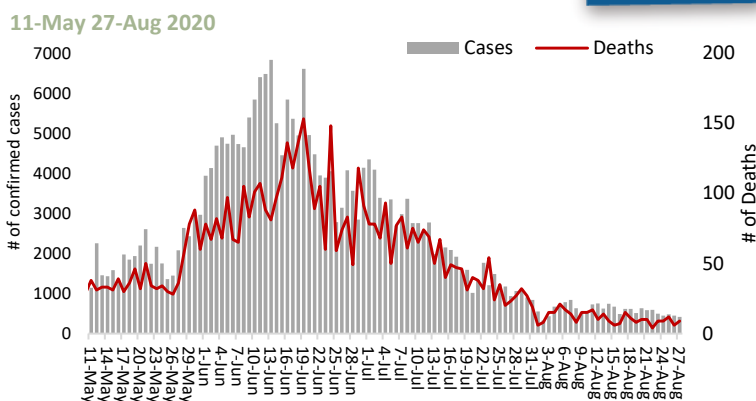
Daily Incidence by Province

Pakistan reported **415** new cases of COVID-19 on **27 August 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **295,053** with **6,283** deaths (CFR: **2.13%**). Out of the total **8,833** currently active cases, **1,083** cases are hospitalized, out of which **644** (**59.46%**) are in critical condition. **7,750** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **279,937** (**94.87%**) have recovered and discharged.



Daily Incidence/Mortality

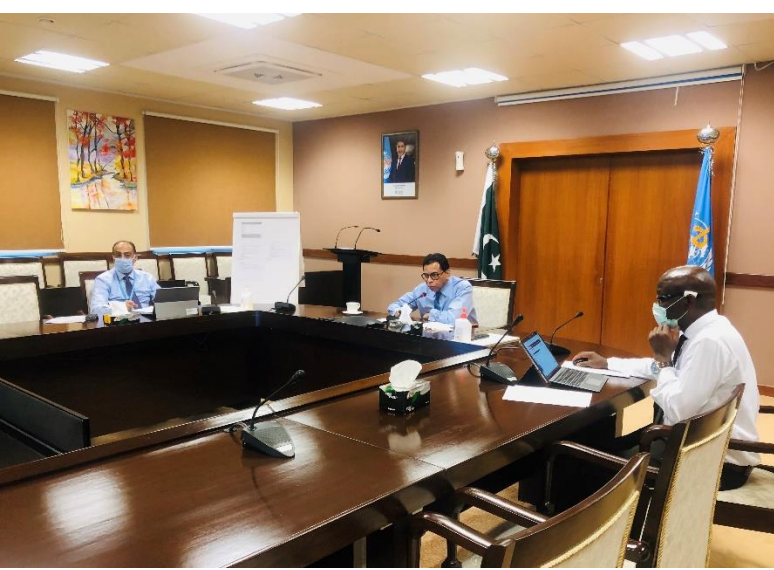

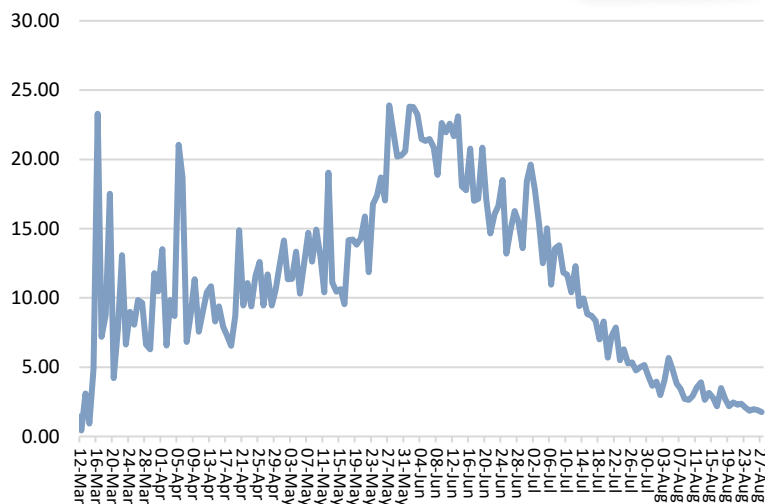


Trainings

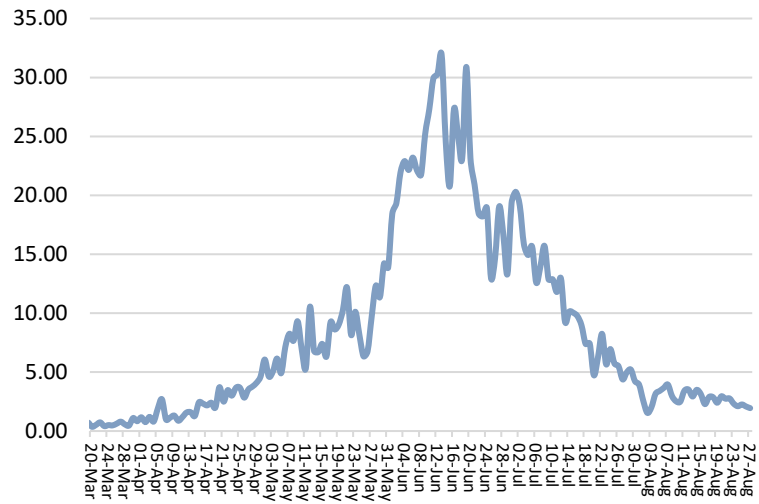
WHO country representative, Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala chaired a virtual meeting with the WHO Pakistan Technical Advisory committee on 27 August 2020 at WHO country office, Islamabad.

Topics discussed by the team of experts include preliminary findings of the COVID-19 Sero-prevalence study, declining incidence of COVID-19 in Pakistan, continuation of provision of essential health services and the proposed plan by the government to open schools in Pakistan.

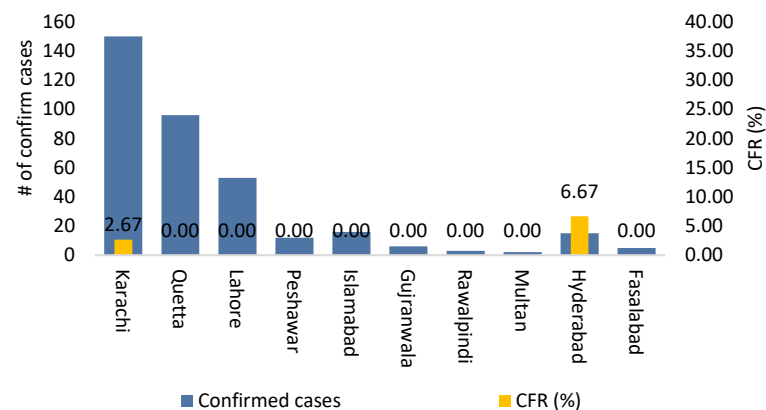

by Major Cities / Districts

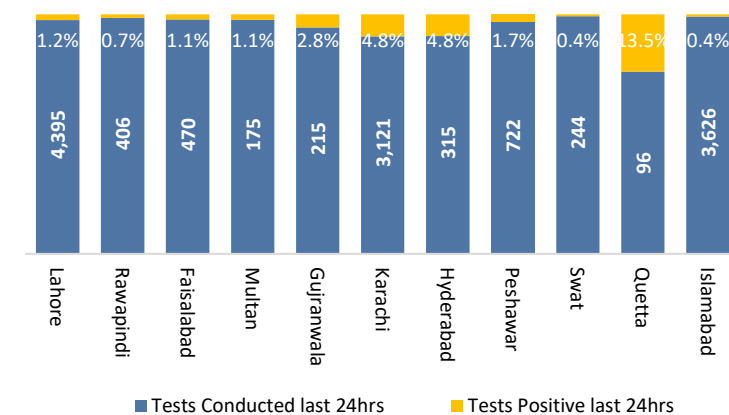

by Major Cities / Districts

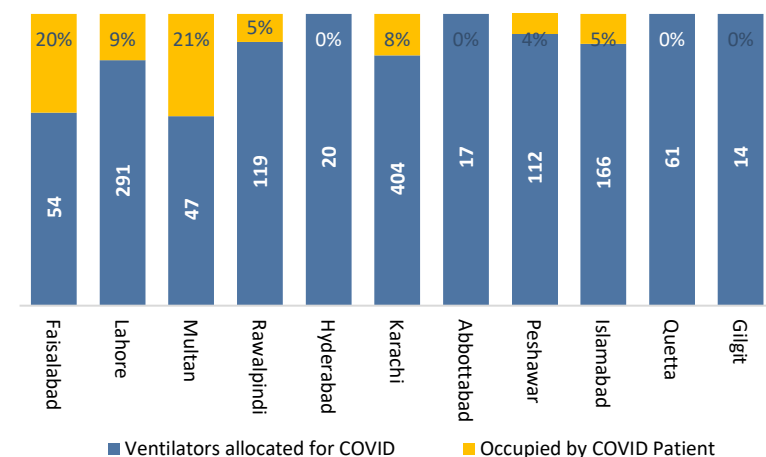
