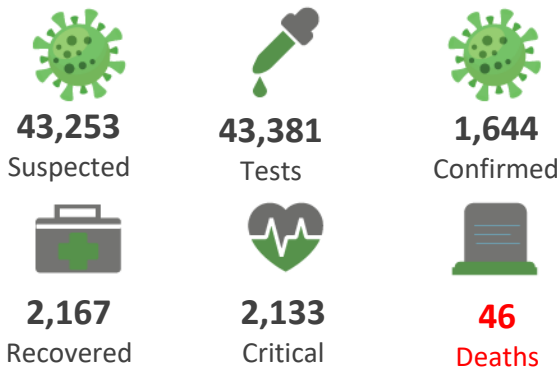


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



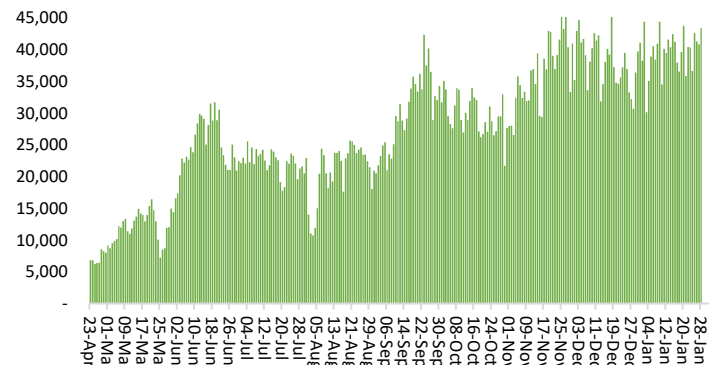
Pakistan reported **1,644** new cases of COVID-19 on **28 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **541,031** with **11,560** deaths (**CFR: 2.14%**). Out of the total **33,726** currently active cases **2,590** cases are hospitalized.

PAKISTAN UPDATES (Last 24hr)



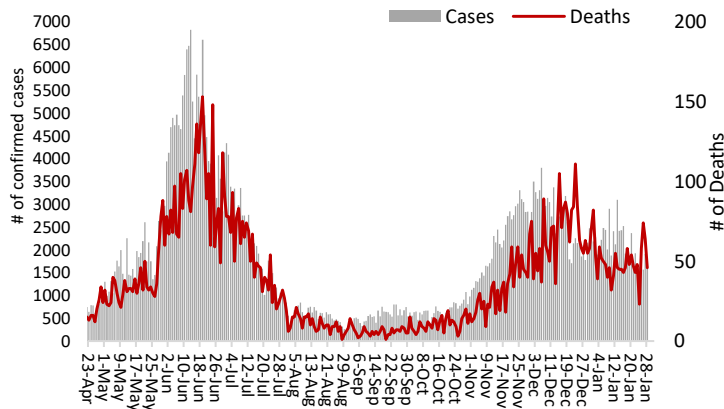
LAB TEST (PCR + RA) CONDUCTED BY DATE

23-April 2020 - 28-Jan 2021

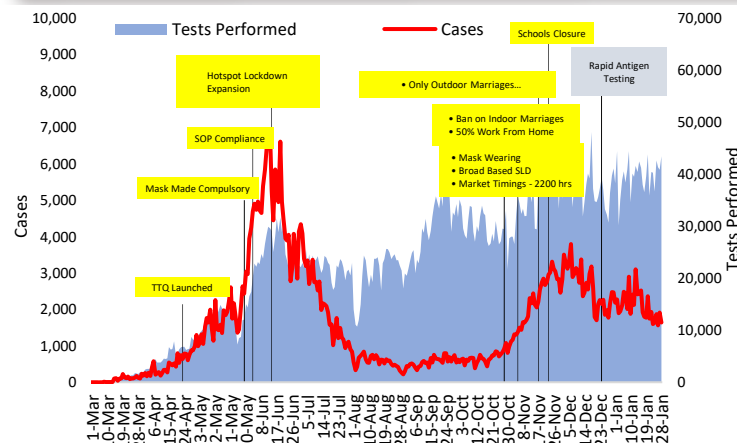


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 28th January 2021, WHO Country Representative in Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala chaired a virtual meeting with EMRO Regional Adviser for Vaccine Preventable Disease and Immunization (VPI), Dr Quamrul Hassan and EMRO Regional Adviser Access to Medicines & Health Technologies, Dr Houda Langar. The objective of the meeting was to discuss among others Pakistan's request for COVID-19 vaccine support through the COVAX facility. WHE Cluster Lead Dr Michael Lukwiya, Medical Officer EPI, Dr Osama Mere, and NPO IHR Dr Farah Sabih, participated in the meeting.

During the meeting, the Regional Advisors were briefed on the current situation of Pakistan preparedness to receive and administer COVID-19 vaccines. The WR highlighted that WHO country office is working with Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination; the Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan and EPI program and has provided technical support, IT support and capacity building on AEFI surveillance and data management.
