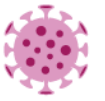

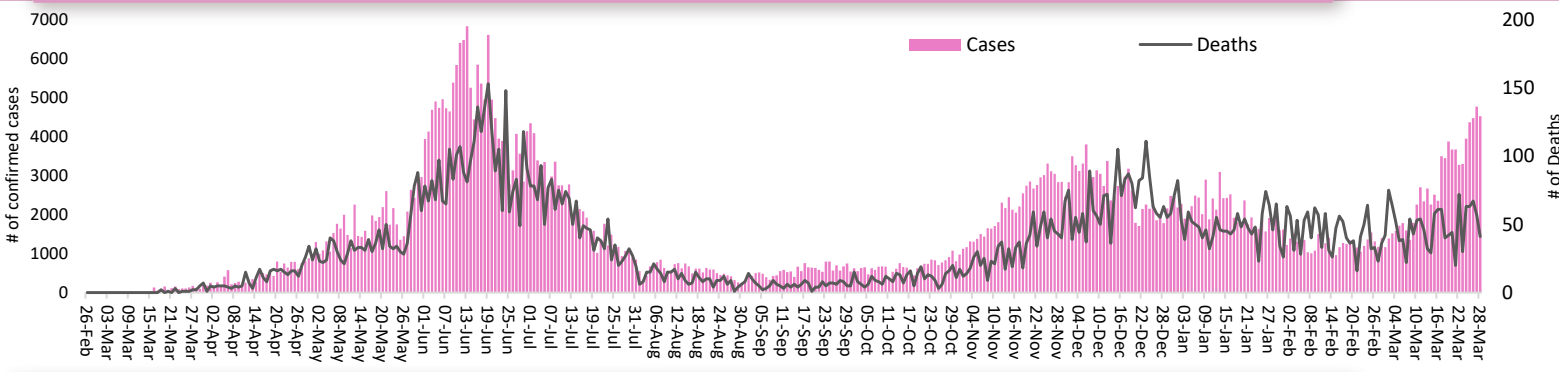

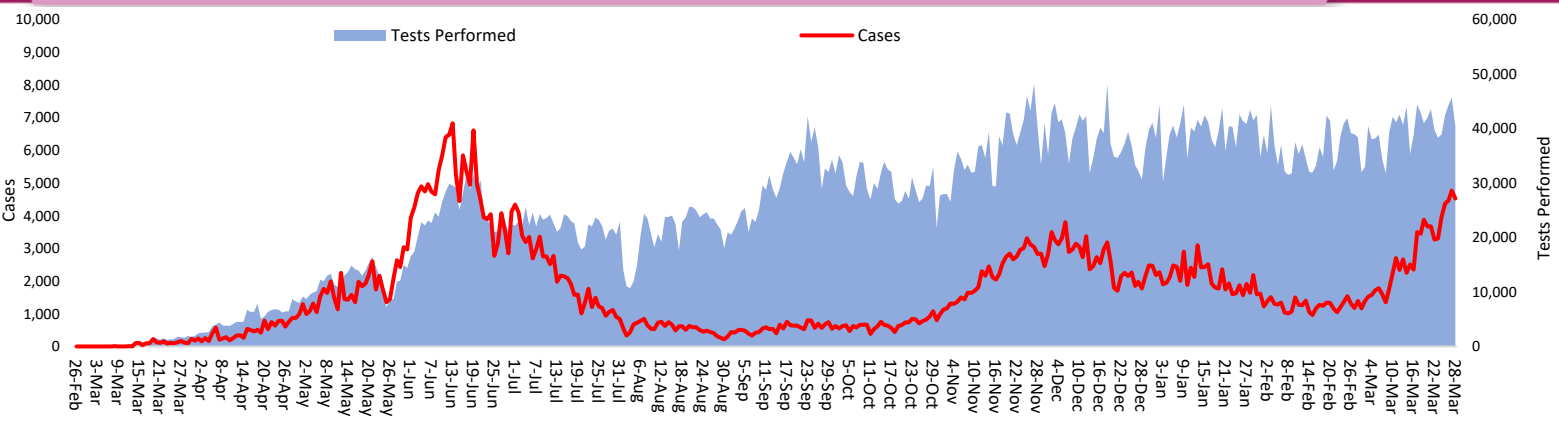

MEETING AND COORDINATION

On 29th March 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala along with the Polio Coordinator, WHO Pakistan, Dr Zainul Abedin visited District Health Office Rawalpindi. During the visit, the WR met with the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) (Health) Rawalpindi Dr Faiza Kanwal and District Health Officer (Preventive Services) Dr Ahsan Ghani. The purpose of the visit was to discuss the epidemiology of Wild Polio Virus in Rawalpindi district during 2020-2021, and the recent circulation of Vaccine Derived Polio Virus 1 (VDPV1) in safdarabad, Rawalpindi. He also discussed the preparations for the NID and training of Polio teams.

While on the visit, the WR inaugurated NIDs campaign in Union Council (UC) 11, visited fix sites in UC 10, visited the High Risk Mobile Population (HRMP) in UC 10, checked on the cold chain and randomly visited some households and interacted with the residents regarding Polio Campaign and the need to observe SOPs for control of COVID-19.
