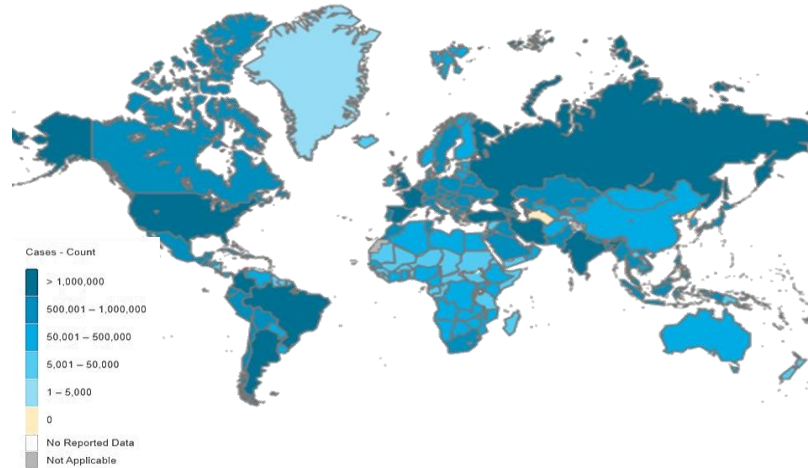




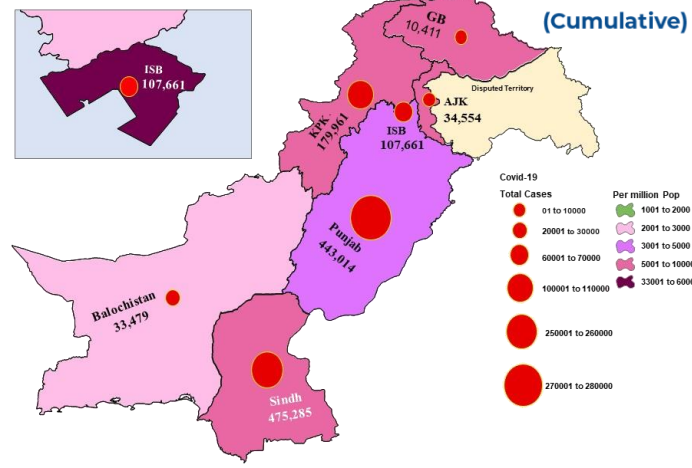

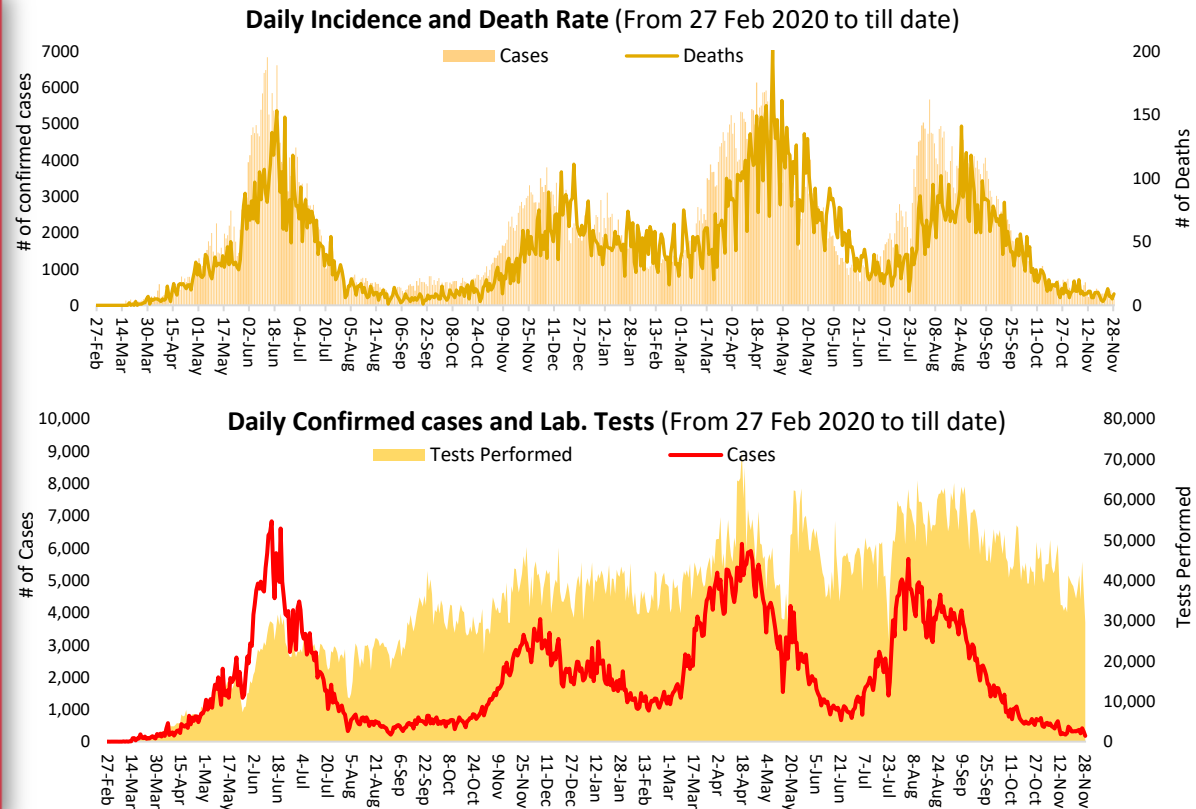

On 29th November 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala along with WHO/ WHE team lead Dr Michael Lukwiya participated in the opening ceremony of a two-day (29th to 30th November 2021) consultative meeting on Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (IDSR) at Ramada Hotel, Islamabad. The objective of the meeting is to review the draft IDSR strategic framework, National Action Plan and Training module with all Heads of WHO Sub offices and surveillance officers. The draft documents have been developed by the MONHSR&C/ NIH with technical support from WHO and Partners; PHE.

As part of the ongoing consultations, the three documents will be discussed further with the Provincial stakeholders from the 1st to 2nd December 2021. Dr Palitha urged the WHO officers to use this opportunity to ensure the documents address the surveillance needs of the country.
