

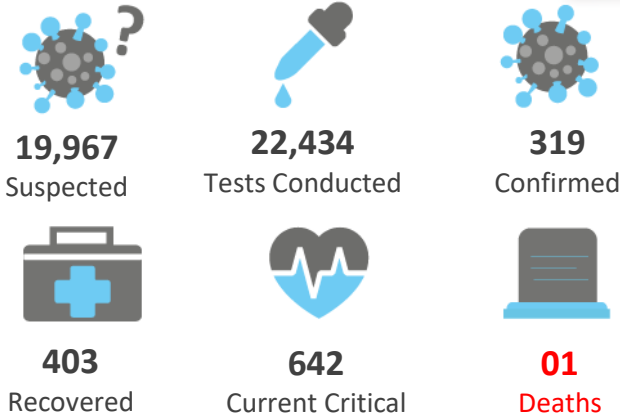

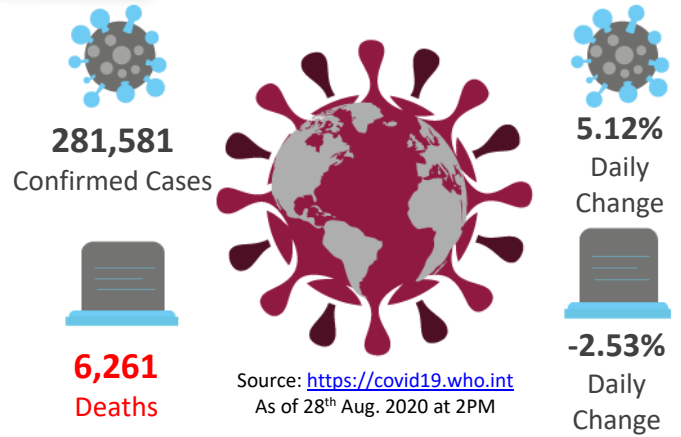

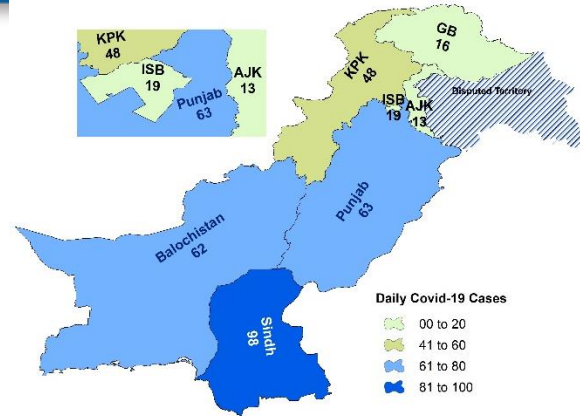

Executive Summary

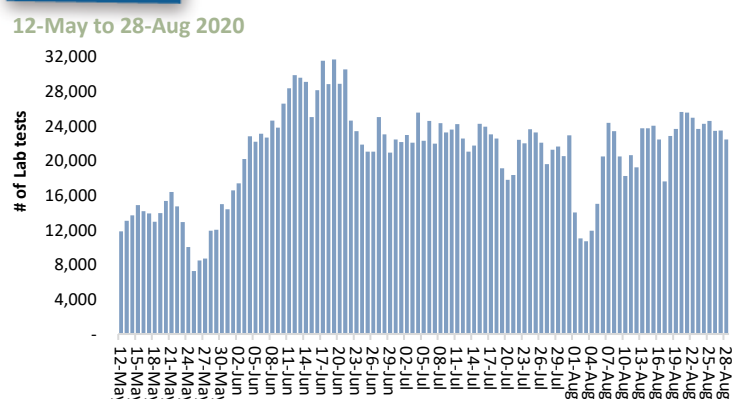
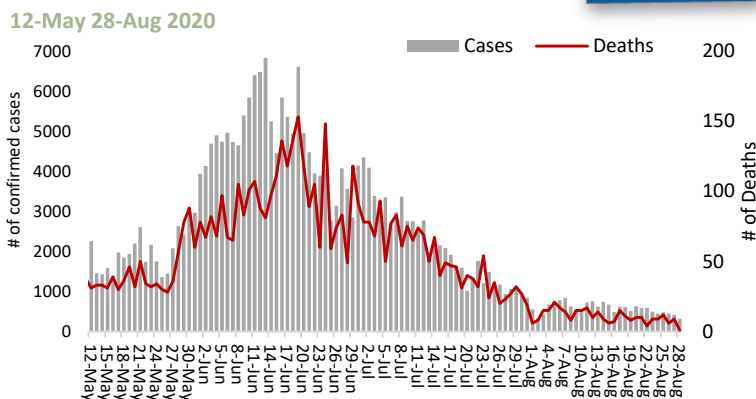
Daily Incidence by Province

Pakistan reported **319** new cases of COVID-19 on **28 August 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **295,372** with **6,284** deaths (CFR: **2.12%**). Out of the total **8,748** currently active cases, **1,084** cases are hospitalized, out of which **642 (59.22%)** are in critical condition. **7,664** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **280,340 (94.91%)** have recovered and discharged.

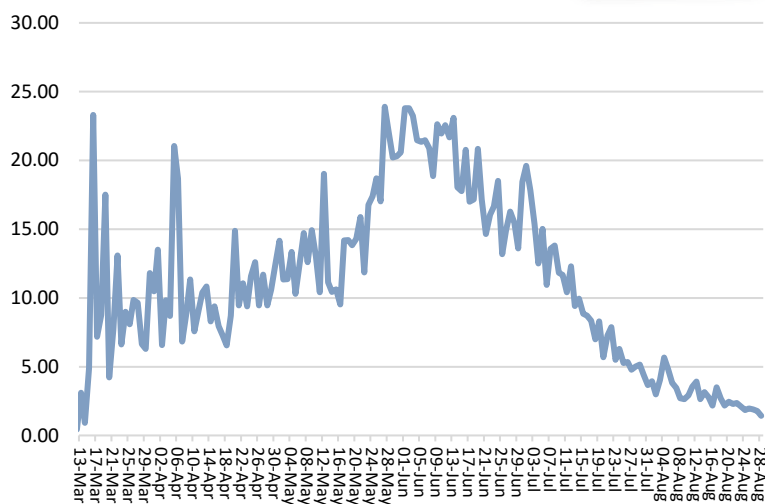


Trainings

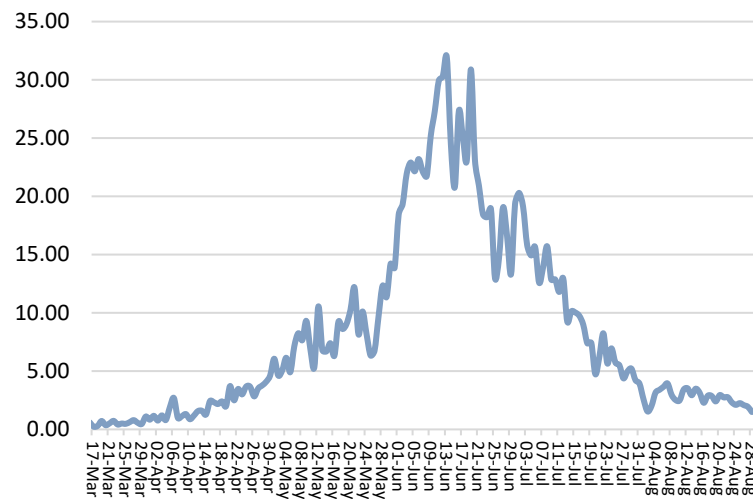
World Health Organization, Pakistan in collaboration with the department of health, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has conducted a case management training for COVID-19 on 24th August 2020 at Hayatabad Medical Complex, Peshawar.

Twenty-nine participants drawn from major hospitals of the KP Province. Following topics were covered during the training; management of mild to moderate COVID-19 cases, role of oxygen and its different modes, indications and monitoring under WHO guidelines, different trails especially solidarity trail and recovery trails and its different arms.

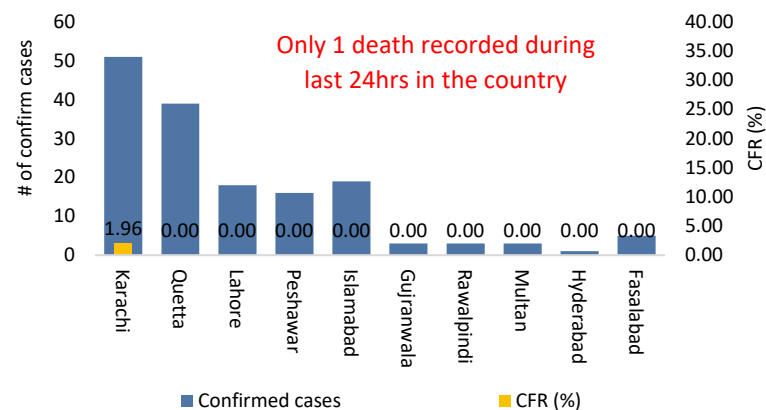

by Major Cities / Districts

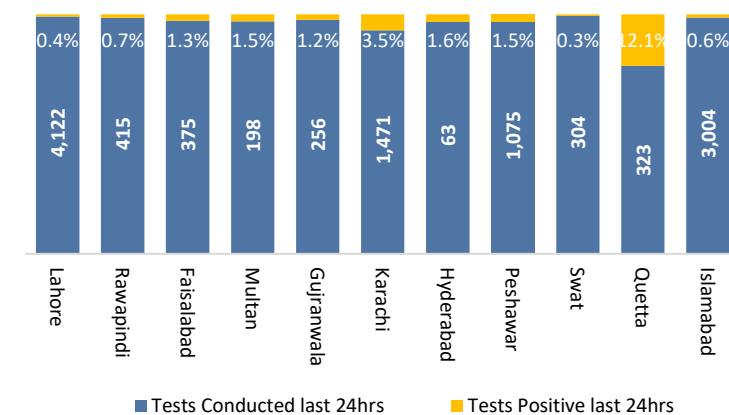

by Major Cities / Districts

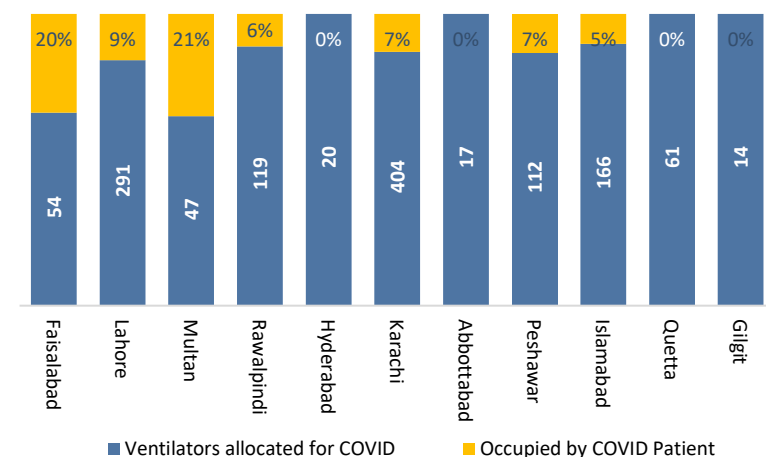
