
PAKISTAN CIVID-19 SITUATION REPORT





Meeting and Coordination











On 30th May 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr. Palitha Mahipala, along with WHO EPI Team lead Dr. Osama Mere visited the COVID -19 vaccination facilities in G-9 and F-9 Park, Islamabad. They were received at the facility by the District Health Officer, Dr. Zaeem Zia.

The purpose of the visit was to oversee the progress on the refurbishment that is being undertaken with support from WHO. The refurbishment will in effect upgrade the capacity of the facilities to vaccinate over 10,000 persons daily following the extension of eligibility of vaccination by the Pakistan government to 19 years and above

Dr. Palitha appreciated the staff working in F9 Park mass vaccination center and commended the Pakistan Government for the establishment of an efficiently managed vaccination center. He noted that this will go a long way in reducing the waiting time at the vaccination center, and further requested the team to ensure work on the site is completed within a week to enable citizens access high quality services.
