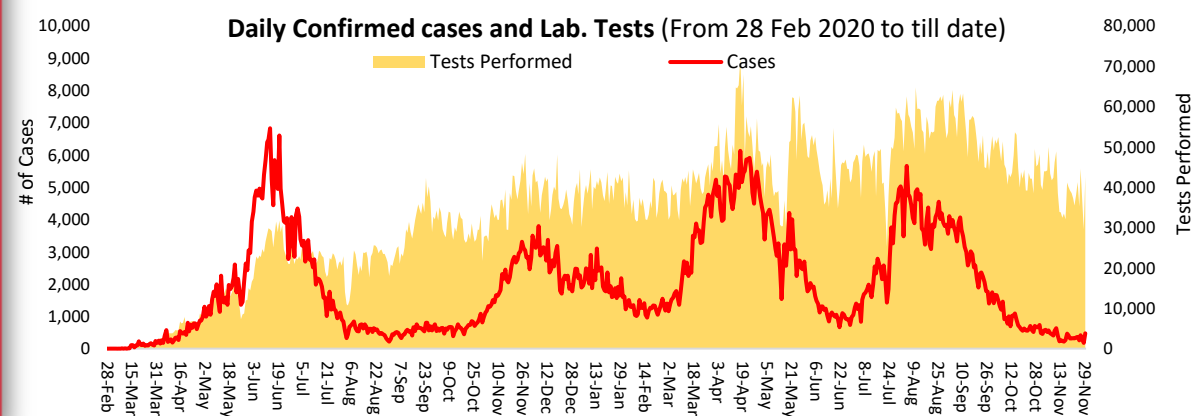

On 27th November 2021, WHO Regional Director for the Eastern Mediterranean Dr Ahmed Al-Mandhari along with WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala inaugurated the refurbished High Dependency Unit (HDU) at Pakistan Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS) Hospital, Islamabad. The 12 bed HDU was refurbished and equipped with funding from WHO Pakistan. The WHO team were received at PIMS hospital by the Joint Executive Director, Dr Ejaz Qadeer. It is envisaged that the HDU facility will benefit the critical cases of dengue infection from Islamabad as well as adjacent districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Punjab, and AJK. Dr Ejaz thanked WHO for the technical and financial support in upgrading the HDU. Dr Palitha and Dr. Al-Mandhari reiterated WHO commitment to quality patient management and urged the PIMS Hospital management to put the refurbished facility to good use.
