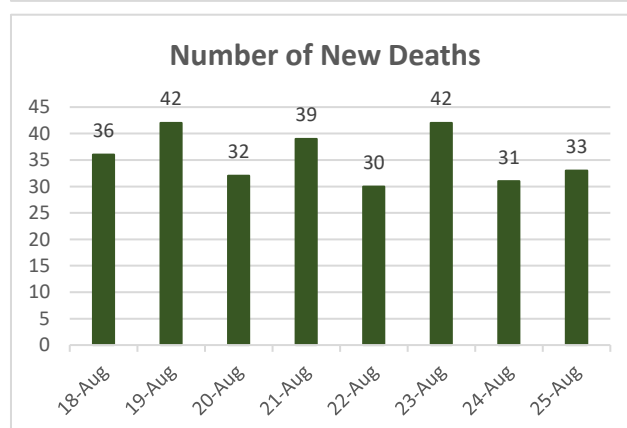
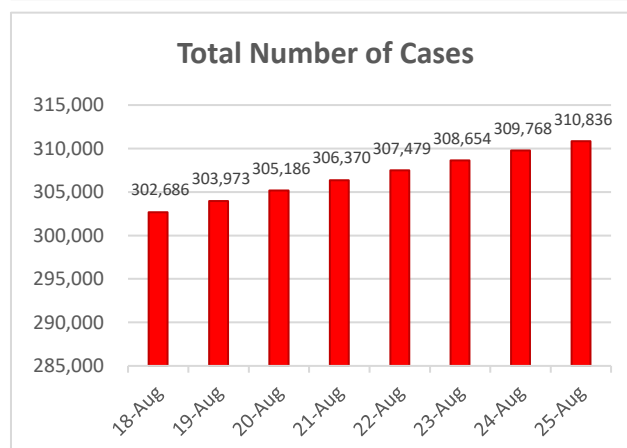
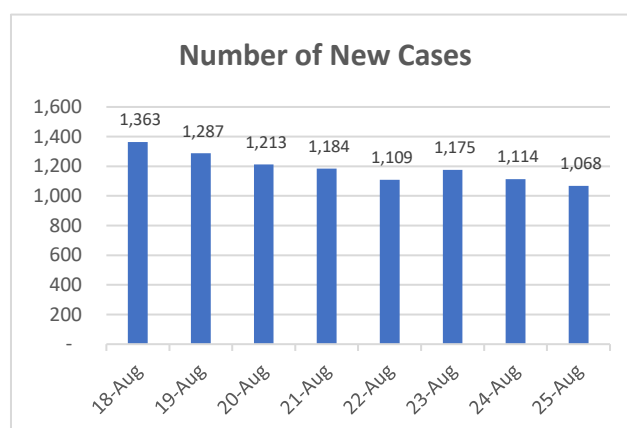

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Out of newly confirmed cases, 44% are female and 10% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections were: Jazan (84), Makkah (67), Madinah (57), Riyadh (55), Tabouk (48), Al Harjah (35), Hail (31), Jeddah (31), and Hufuf (30).
